CURRENT EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES

JOINT CITY COUNCIL, TOWN OF BELOIT SUPERVISORS MEETING

On **Monday, July 23, 2012 at 6:30 p.m.**, the Beloit City Council and the Town of Beloit Board will convene a joint meeting at the Rotary River Center, 1160 Riverside Drive, Beloit. A copy of the meeting agenda is <u>attached</u>. As you will note, the meeting is a "get to know you" session, which will incorporate some general discussion about the on-going relationship between the City and Town of Beloit.

BUDGET PREPARATION

Most of the available time this week was devoted to budget preparation. We have reached that point in the 2013 budget preparation cycle, where the budget review team is meeting with each individual department and division director to go through their initial budget requests. That process will continue through next week. We also have more meetings scheduled with various department heads and division directors regarding the five-year Capital Improvements Plan, which is also undergoing preparation at this time.

NATIONAL NIGHT OUT

On Tuesday, August 7 from 5:30-8:30 p.m., the City will celebrate its' 29th annual National Night Out. Once again this year there will be a series of block parties and picnics throughout the City of Beloit. DROUGHT CONTINUES—TERRACE TREE WATERING REQUEST

The Public Works Department has issued and continues to request that residents assist the City by watering terrace trees that have been planted in front of their homes in the last two to three years. Young trees without deep root structures are susceptible to damage, even dying, in the extremely dry conditions that we have experienced this summer. The City has redeployed much of its seasonal staff and has multiple crews watering trees, landscaping and other plantings to minimize loss during this unusually dry and hot summer season. We would also urge residents while you're out watering terrace trees, be sure you also give thought to other plantings on your property, particularly anything that has been planted in the last two to three years and may not have a deep, fully established root structure.

CITY CENTER COMMITTEE REVIEWS FINAL DRAFT OF "CONNECTIONS PLAN"

The City Center Committee met on Thursday afternoon and reviewed the final draft of the construction plan, which was prepared by a consultant with considerable input from both the cities of Beloit and South Beloit, along with other key stakeholders. The plan would provide for the connection of pedestrian and bicycle path that would connect both communities and tie together the Wisconsin and Illinois bike/pedestrian path systems.


