Common **misuse** of Emergency Medical Services includes:

- Minor cuts and scrapes
- Toothache– with no cardiac history
- Earache– without stroke history
- Foreign body in eyes or ears
- Common cold and flu, minor fever
- Transportation to hospital for scheduled appointments
- Or any **Non Life-Threatening** Injury or Illness

Continual **misuse** of the Emergency Medical System constitutes **“Ambulance Abuse”**, a violation of Local Ordinance.

Emergency Medical Service Systems (EMS) are designed to respond to **life-threatening illness and injuries** only.

In the event of severe illness and injury City of Beloit Fire Department Paramedics provide the citizens of the Greater Beloit Community with **Advanced Life Support** and transport immediately to Beloit Memorial Hospital Emergency Department.

The **misuse** of EMS services will delay response to those suffering from life-threatening illnesses and injury and jeopardize essential care and treatment.

Continual **misuse** of the Emergency Medical System constitutes "**Ambulance Abuse**", a violation of Local Ordinance.

Non Life-Threatening Illness, Injury, or Crisis Intervention -

You should seek care and treatment for non life-threatening illness, injury, or crisis intervention and mental health issues from your personal physician, Convenient-Care, Public Health Clinics, or Mental Health Professional.
