Yard Waste Collection

August 3, 2012 – On Friday, August 3, the Department of Public Works completed the tremendous task of storm recovery due to the severe storm that took place on July 24, 2012. Director of Operations, Chris Walsh said, “Our crews exemplified what Public Works is about—just get the job done.”

Beginning Monday, August 6, yard waste stickers must be affixed to each bag, container, or bundle. Yard waste must be properly contained in a clean container, paper, or Back to Nature bio-degradable yard waste bag. Containers may be no larger than 39 gallons and weigh no more than 60 pounds. Yard waste cannot be contained in plastic bags. A \$1.50 sticker must be affixed to each bag, container and or bundles.
