You are invited to attend a Public Informational Meeting for a project involving the potential roadway connection improvements between Prairie Avenue and Shopiere Road in the City of Beloit, Town of Beloit, and Town of Turtle in Rock County. Rock County has retained the engineering services of Ayres Associates to conduct the study and prepare associated plans and specifications for this project. The purpose of this meeting is to present the latest design alternatives and concepts, discuss the project schedule, and gather public input. The meeting will be held in an open house format, and project exhibits will be on display for review. There will be a brief presentation at 6:30 p.m. to provide an overview of the project. Before and after the presentation, project staff will be available to talk to attendees on an individual basis.

Construction of a connector route between Prairie Avenue and Shopiere Road would likely occur no sooner than 2014.

A comment form is enclosed with this letter on which you can provide information on any issues or concerns that may prove helpful to the design staff. Feel free to discuss these at the meeting, or you can mail to the address shown on the comment form.

Persons with an interest or knowledge about historic buildings/structures and archaeological sites in the project area are encouraged to include such information as part of any comments submitted.
