This past Tuesday, November 27, the Beloit City Council and the Town of Turtle Board held their first joint meeting. It was both a "get to know you" session and a general discussion regarding possible areas of collaboration and shared service delivery, along with a general discussion about issues that should be addressed during the upcoming negotiations to extend an existing Boundary Area Agreement. It is anticipated that negotiating committees representing both the Town and the City will begin negotiations in December.

CITY COUNCIL MEETING - MONDAY, DECEMBER 3, 2012

The City Council will have a <u>Closed Session Meeting at 5:30 p.m.</u> in the City Manager's Conference Room. The purpose for the closed session will be to provide additional updated information on a pending real estate transaction.

The City Council will hold a **workshop at 6:30 p.m.** in the City Manager's Conference Room, 4th Floor, on Monday, December 3 for the purpose of reviewing the agenda of the regular 7:00 p.m. City Council meeting.

The attached agenda is for the Monday, December 3, 2012 regular City Council meeting beginning at 7:00 p.m. in the Forum.

4. PUBLIC HEARINGS

a. Public hearing and Resolution authorizing a **Conditional Use Permit** to allow a drive-through facility as part of the new Associated Bank building to be located at 602 Henry Avenue. This new facility is being constructed on the north end of the Eclipse Center facility. After reviewing the application, the Plan Commission voted 4-0 to recommend for approval.

Because of the proximity of the Vision Beloit facility to the adjacent church property, each special event license issued must receive concurrence by the City Council.

7. ORDINANCES

a. This is a series of revisions to the Solid Waste Ordinance. This is an update to the City's existing Solid Waste regulations and was prepared by the Department of Public Works, Division of Operations, in conjunction with the City Attorney's office. The ordinance includes general modifications needed to remain compliant with various State standards, as well as provide updates in the old language to ensure compliance with current operations. The ordinance is on the agenda for first review.

11. REPORTS FROM BOARD AND CITY OFFICERS

a. Resolution accepting Bradley G. Heyerdahl and Nanci L. Hanson Heyerdahl's **Offer to Purchase** Lots 293 and 294 of Poff's Fourth Sun Valley in the City of Beloit. The City has made efforts in the past to market this land to a property developer, but the most recent effort (in the fall of 2010) failed. The owners of 2001 Frederick have expressed an interest in purchasing land to expand their yard. Staff is recommending that the Council approve this sale, with the money received going into the General Fund Land Sale account.

October 16, 2012 – Beloit, WI: Any City of Beloit resident interested in running for a two-year term on the Beloit City Council may pick up a packet of information including nomination papers beginning **Monday, October 29, 2012.** The packets are available in the office of the City Clerk on the second floor of City Hall during normal business hours: Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

- There are seven members on the Council and three seats will be on the ballot.
- Candidates must file required forms with the City Clerk before forming a committee and raising funds.
- The first day to circulate nomination papers is **Saturday, December 1, 2012**.
- Between 200 and 400 valid signatures of City of Beloit residents must be submitted.
- Nomination papers and all forms must be completed and filed with the City Clerk by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 2, 2013.
- An informational session will be held in January for all candidates who have gained ballot access.
- The Spring Election will be held on **Tuesday, April 2, 2013**.
- Newly-elected Councilors will take office on Tuesday, April 16, 2013.
