#### **NATIONAL NIGHT OUT**

Once again, the Police Department, Fire Department and the Greater Beloit Area Crime Stoppers organization will celebrate our 30th National Night Out. This year's events are scheduled for Tuesday, August 6 from 5:30—8:30 p.m. As always, there will be parties, picnics and cookouts in various neighborhoods, churches and schools located throughout the Greater Beloit community. If you have held a neighborhood get-together in the past, we would urge you to participate again this year. #### PARKS TOUR SCHEDULED FOR JULY 10TH

In lieu of their July meeting, the Park, Recreation and Conservation Advisory Commission will conduct their annual parks tour. Accompanied by a number of administrative officials and members of the Beloit City Council, the Commission will tour a number of park sites again this year. The purpose of the tour is for the Commissioners to visit various parks facilities, evaluate current conditions and needed improvements at the visited sites. #### **BUDGET PREPARATION**

The Departments and Divisions have been working hard to complete their budget submittals, which were due on July 3, 2013. Finance Department staff will be inputting information into the budget relative to salaries and compensation, interest and debt payments, as well as completing various revenue projections. The recently adopted State budget appears to be neutral with regard to municipalities, meaning the municipalities receive no additional funding, nor did they lose any funding. This is the first time in the last three budget cycles that municipalities have not received significant reductions in State aids. The week of July 22, 2013 has been set aside for major budget reviews with the Director of Finance and Administrative Services and the City Manager. These meetings will include a complete line item review of every component of the budget which will, hopefully, bring the budget to balance.

#### LEAGUE OF WISCONSIN MUNICIPALITIES—SUMMER BOARD MEETING/RETREAT

The Board of Directors of the League of Wisconsin Municipalities will meet next week for their summer board meeting and retreat. In addition to a full business schedule, the Board will also be discussing strategic planning.
