There are 23 park sites, 2 Cemeteries, plus the Turtle Creek Floodplain and countless special use areas and/or facilities all located on the east side of the city. Annually, we've always attempted to conduct this tour in within a 4 hour time period as it eventually becomes too dark to see after 9:00pm. Based upon our meeting in April, I have attempted to revise this schedule to include all sites as some Commissioners appear to be unaware of some of these sites. However, I have placed an asterisk (*) next to the sites that I am only recommending that we simply drive by and not stop, unless someone has special request to do so. Furthermore, I have totally eliminated our visit to Pohlman Field and the Snappers Clubhouse as they have a home game on this date, and they are unable to accommodate us on this date.

As in previous years, this schedule is always flexible, and we can extend our stops and/or shorten them based upon your desires as we conduct this tour.
