COUNCIL TO HOLD SPECIAL MEETING WITH CLOSED SESSION

On Tuesday, August 6, 2013, from 5:30-8:30 pm, residents in neighborhoods throughout Beloit are asked to turn on outside lights and spend the evening outside with their neighbors. Last year over 30 neighborhood blocks registered to participate in Beloit's National Night Out celebration.



FIRE HYDRANT FLUSHING

The City of Beloit Water Resources Division will be performing their annual fire hydrant flushing program from July 15, 2013 through November 01, 2013.

This flushing program ensures that the fire hydrants are in good working condition in case of emergencies and to help flush sediment out of the distribution system.

You may experience discolored water, low water pressure or a disruption of service during this time period. Residents are urged to reduce water use and consumption during this time period and wait to do laundry until <u>AFTER</u> 6:00 p.m. during the flushing program.

During evening hours residents should open their cold water faucets until the water runs clear before using it.
