CITY COUNCIL ACTION

The City Council held a special meeting on Monday, September 23, 2013 for the purpose of considering a recommendation from the Alcohol Beverage License Control Committee that the Alcohol Beverage License for Adiktion, 1310 Cranston Road, be suspended for a period of 60 days. After discussion, the City Council voted to suspend the Class "B" Beer and "Class B" Liquor License of Adiktion for 90 days beginning on Thursday, September 26, 2013.

BUDGET PREPARATION—IMPORTANT DATES TO NOTE

The 2014 proposed budget has now been completed and work is progressing on all of the narrative pages and the budget transmittal letter that must be finalized before the document can be presented to Council and the community.

Wednesday, October 2, 2013

The proposed budget will be posted to the City's website on Wednesday, October 2, 2013, at the same time the agenda will be posted for the October 7, 2013 Council meeting.

Monday, October 7, 2013

The City Manager and Finance and Administrative Services Director will officially present the budget at that regular City Council meeting beginning at 7:00 p.m. in the Forum here at City Hall (100 State Street).

Monday, October 14, 2013

At the Council meeting on October 7, we will recommend scheduling a **full day workshop** for Monday, October 14 to go through the detailed components of the budget document with the City Council. That meeting will be held at the **Beloit Public Library Community Room, 605 Eclipse Blvd., beginning at 8:00 a.m.** and will continue until the process is concluded, usually by 5:00 p.m. The entire session will be open and the public is invited to attend.

Monday, October 21, 2013

It should be noted that the workshop on October 14th is not the public hearing on the budget, which has been scheduled for Monday, October 21, 2013 to be held as part of the regular City Council meeting beginning at 7:00 p.m. in the Forum here at City Hall.
