Prisoner Escape from Custody

On November 21, 2013 at 340pm officers from the City of Beloit Police Department responded to 1146 Grant St in Beloit, the Adult Probation and Parole office regarding a subject that they wished to taken into custody for a probation violation.

The subject taken into custody was Michael A. Kane, 40 years of age, Beloit resident. Kane is 5'10" tall, weighing 170 pounds, with brown hair, and brown eyes. Kane was wearing blue jeans and a camouflage jacket. Kane's criminal history involves property crime and illegal narcotics.



Kane was secured in handcuffs and transported to the City of Beloit Police Department. While in the garage area prior to being taken into the Police Department Prisoner holding area, Kane was able to flee on foot. Law Enforcement is actively searching for Kane for the Probation Violation, Felony Escape, and Theft.
