

Beloit Public Library Begins New Director Search

Beloit, Wis. — The Beloit Public Library has initiated a search for a new Library Director.

Beloit Public Library Board of Trustees accepted Nathan Deprey's resignation on Thursday, Nov. 7 and appointed Jennifer Laatz and Jeni Schomber co-interim directors at their regular board meeting on Wednesday, Nov. 20.

The selection process will be facilitated by Lynn Elam Consulting of Batavia, Ill. along with a special selection committee. The Beloit Public Library Board of Trustees hopes to hire a new director by April 1, 2014 with a start date of May 1.
