February 28, 2014 – Beloit, WI: As part of the City of Beloit's efforts to protect resources and become more sustainable, the City Treasury is proud to offer paperless e-statements for all City of Beloit utility customers. E-statements are available to all customers, whether you currently pay your utility bill via an automatic payment from your checking or savings account, through electronic banking, online, over the phone, in person, at a City Hall drop box, or by mail.

Benefits of this program include:

- Environmental friendliness e-statements save paper and make customer record-keeping more efficient
- Cost savings for postage, printing, and mailing help keep utility rates low
- Delivery and receipt delays due to mailing paper bills or statements are eliminated

Utility e-statements will be emailed at the same time of the month as the bill or paper statement would normally be mailed. You may enroll in this program through the City Treasury's section of the City's website: www.ci.beloit.wi.us or by clicking here.
