ABSENTEE VOTING IN PERSON FOR THE SPRING ELECTION

Beginning Monday, March 17, 2014, electors registered to vote in the City of Beloit may cast an absentee ballot in person for the April 1, 2014 Spring Election. Please see the <u>attached</u> press release issued by the City Clerk's office for more information.

BELOIT UTILITIES NOW OFFERS E-STATEMENTS FOR CUSTOMER CONVENIENCE

We again want to remind customers that Beloit Utilities is now offering an option for E-statements. This option offers a new, more convenient way for you to manage your bills and maintain electronic files as well. This option will improve convenience for customers who utilize their computers for managing their personal business affairs and also save the City of Beloit Water Utility the cost of paper, printing and postage to send the traditional paper bill. If you are interested in signing up for E-statements, please click here for a link to the appropriate page. You will need your account number, and of course an e-mail address. Simply complete the form and transition your future bills to an electronic format.

The Utility will continue to send paper statements each month to customers that would prefer to receive a traditional paper document for processing their monthly payments. No action needs to be taken to maintain the paper bills that you currently receive.

CHARTER COMMUNICATIONS MAKES CHANGES TO PUBLIC ACCESS AND/OR GOVERNMENT CHANNELS

In the coming months, Charter will make significant changes to their video service, including updating to an all-digital network. Beginning April 1, 2014, Beloit City Council meetings will continue to be broadcast live on Channel 992 at 7:00 p.m. on the first and third Mondays of each month. Meetings will also be rebroadcast during the week of the Council meeting on Channel 992 on Tuesday at 1:00 p.m., Thursday at 8:30 a.m., and Friday at 1:00 p.m. All questions regarding these changes should be directed to Charter Communications at (888) 438-2427 or 2016 Cranston Road, Beloit, WI.

SPRING FINALLY ARRIVES IN BELOIT

Yesterday, Thursday, March 20 at 11:57 a.m., Spring officially arrived here in the upper Midwest. We've been fortunate so far this spring to have a gradual thawing and melt off of the large snow accumulation. Capacity in both Turtle Creek and the Rock River is substantial, and unless torrential rains overwhelm the watershed we should have sufficient capacity this year. Weather conditions remain on the cold side of average and much snow cover remains. Public Works crews are out in-force doing pothole patching and the normal cleanup operations that are done each spring, including street sweeping. I would also like to encourage residents and business owners to check their property for accumulated litter and debris which normally builds up throughout the winter season. Additional work will be commencing on the city parks and other public properties as weather conditions continue to improve.

BOARD APPROVES BOND FINANCING FOR 2014 CAPITAL SPENDING PLAN

On Monday evening March 17, 2014, the City Council actually heard two presentations from Mike Harrigan of Ehlers providing a detailed analysis of proposed bond financing included in the 2014 Operating and Capital Budget to cover the cost of many of the infrastructure improvements and equipment purchases included in the 2014 budget. Following the detailed presentation by Ehlers, Council approved the funding which included approximately \$3.5 million in bonds and notes to finance the 2014 program, and an additional refunding of approximately \$6 million of 2007 GO debt that will save approximately \$200,000 in interest expenses over the balance of the debt repayment schedule.

COMMUNITY CHAMPION WEEK FOR MEALS ON WHEELS

Once again this year, the City Manager volunteered to deliver meals to homebound seniors and disabled residents, which is the mission of the Meals on Wheels program. The Community Champion week program provides opportunities for local elected and appointed officials to visit the Meals on Wheels facility, participate in the home deliveries, and most importantly an opportunity to interact with many of the program participants. I was fortunate to be able to participate on Wednesday, March 19, 2014 with other local officials. Many of the City Councilors were able to volunteer for this or another day this week, as well. Once again, we are always impressed with Beloit's award-winning program and extend our congratulations and thanks to Marcy Reedy, Executive Director, as well as the staff, volunteers and sponsors who make this program possible.

Absentee Voting In Person for the Spring Election Available Starting March 17, 2014

March 10, 2014 – Beloit, WI: Beginning Monday, March 17, 2014, electors registered to vote in the City of Beloit may cast an absentee ballot in person for the April 1, 2014 Spring Election. Electors who are not registered to vote and those who need to change their names and/or addresses must bring proof of residence to register. Please find the acceptable forms of proof of residence on the following page.

Late registration and absentee voting in person will be available from **Monday, March 17**th **through Friday, March 28**th in the City Clerk's office on the second floor of City Hall. Electors who would like an absentee ballot mailed to them must make the request in writing via email to lemirer@ci.beloit.wi.us; via mail to 100 State Street, Beloit, WI 53511; or in person at the City Clerk's office.

Photo identification or other proof of identity will **not** be required to obtain an absentee ballot or to obtain a regular ballot on Election Day at the polling place for this Election.

ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF PROOF OF RESIDENCE

One of the following is required to register to vote in the Clerk's office during the closed registration period or on Election Day at the Polling Place:

- A current and valid Wisconsin driver's license
- A current and valid Wisconsin identification card
- Any other Official ID Card or license issued by a Wisconsin Governmental body
- An ID card with your photo issued by an employer during the normal course of business (not including a business card)
- A real estate tax bill or receipt (for the current year or year before the election
- A residential lease which is effective for a period that includes Election Day
- A university, college, or technical college identification card (must include photo) together with a fee payment receipt issued to the cardholder by the university, college or technical college dated no earlier than 9 months before the date of the election at which the receipt is presented
- A utility bill for a period starting no earlier than 90 days before Election Day
- A bank statement or current pay check
- A government check or any other official document issued by a unit of government

NOTE: all of the above must contain a current and complete name, including both first and last name; and a current and complete residential address, including numbered street address, if any, and the name of the municipality. If the form has an expiration date, it must be valid on Election Day. **An individual may not register or vote without one of the above forms of proof of residence.**
