Re: Afternoon Homicide

At 4:22 today, Beloit Police were conducting business in a south western Beloit neighborhood when they heard multiple gunshots. Citizens in the Eighth and Highland area then began calling to report a person firing a weapon, and a vehicle quickly leaving the area. One person was reported being struck by gunfire.

Police and emergency medical personnel arrived on the scene to find one victim with a gunshot wound. The 20 year old victim was transported to Beloit Memorial Hospital where he was pronounced dead.

Police and detectives responding to the scene are conducting an investigation even before beginning reports from the early morning shooting of today. Police do not know if the two incidents are connected but they will quickly evaluate this possibility. Detectives and officers will continue to follow up on any clues received for this incident or the first today.

The victim is Raymond L. Holloway of 556 Highland Avenue in Beloit. Relatives were notified this evening.

It is not likely information will be available before early morning Monday, April 28th.
