#### COUNCILOR LEAVY SUBMITS RESIGNATION FROM CITY COUNCIL

Just prior to the City council meeting this past Monday, Councilor Leavy approached Council President and myself and announced that he would be resigning from the City Council in the immediate future. An e-mail resignation was received in the City Manager's office the following morning, indicating that Councilor Leavy's service on Council will conclude at the end of May, meaning May 31, 2014. Councilor Leavy accepted a new position several months ago, which has required a substantial increase in time commitment and he has had difficulty coordinating his schedule to attend City Council meetings and related activities.

Council will be accepting the resignation and considering a resolution stipulating a replacement process per existing provisions of the Municipal Code.

May 19, 2014 will be Councilor Leavy's final meeting. Kevin has been on Council since 2003 and is currently the longest serving City Councilor. We all extend our sincere thanks and appreciation for all of his service to Beloit and our very best wishes for his continued career and community service activities.

#### **BUDGET/STRATEGIC PLANNING**

The 2015 budget process has begun. The Strategic Plan will be discussed by the City Council at a workshop this coming **Monday**, **May 12**, **2014** beginning at 8:00 a.m. and running throughout the day. The workshop will be held at the Utilities and Engineering building located at 2400 Springbrook and all sessions will be open to the public. Once we receive Council feedback on various elements of the Strategic Plan, the final document will be prepared and likely included on a Council agenda sometime in the month of June for Council consideration.

The Finance Department budget staff held a meeting this past week to begin the process of preparing and submitting Operating budgets for 2015 from the various divisions and departments. The budget calendar was reviewed and a number of issues related to entering budget requests were discussed with the assembled managers. Training will be held for employees that make the actual budget entries later in May. Department and Division Directors will be conducting preliminary research on their financial needs for the coming year over the next several weeks. The submittal of budget information into our software program will not begin until June. Budget review actually begins in mid-July.

City Council to be held on **Monday**, **June 16**, **2014** at **5:30 p.m.**, prior to the regular City Council meeting. The workshop will be held in the Forum at City Hall, 100 State Street.

Later in the morning on **Saturday, May 17, the Beloit Fire Department will host an Open House** (see <u>attached</u>) at the Headquarters Station located at 1111 Church Street. Apparatus and informational displays will be available for public viewing from 10:00 a.m.—2:00 p.m.

#### **SPRING TREE PLANTING**

The City of Beloit's Department of Public Works is accepting requests through Friday, May 30, 2014 from residents for terrace trees to be planted this spring. The terrace tree species selection will be determined by the City Forestry Supervisor, taking into account the size of the terrace, presence of utilities, and exotic invasive insects. Trees will be planted on a first-come, first-served basis. To be placed on the list, please call the Department of Public Works at 608-364-2929.

#### PRIVATE WELL INSPECTION AND PERMITTING PROGRAM

Following the workshop with Council held this past Monday, staff from Public Works and the City Attorney's office are finalizing documents for the May 19, 2014 agenda to introduce an ordinance which makes a number of modifications, most of which are housekeeping in nature, to the City's Water Utility Regulatory Ordinance. Staff has also been doing research on some suggestions made by Councilors at the workshop and will be presenting that information as soon as the research is completed and the material assembled for presentation.

#### VISIT BELOIT INTRODUCES NEW MOBILE WELCOME CENTER

I was indeed honored to be asked to chauffer the new mobile welcome center recently acquired by Visit Beloit. The vehicle has a beautiful wrap graphics package, room for a wide screen monitor that will be rolling video and/or photographs illustrating both on-going activities and special events happening here in the City of Beloit. There will also be information and staff available at the mobile site to answer questions and provide information. The vehicle will be used all over the region, representing the City at community festivals, business expos, and other appropriate sites to help tell Beloit's story and bring visitors to our beautiful community. Monica Krysztopa, Executive Director of Visit Beloit, deserves most of the credit for creating and implementing this significant new initiative that will help tell the Beloit story.

#### UPDATE ON REPLACING FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES DIRECTOR

The Executive Recruiter has now been working for some time on the recruitment process to select the new Finance and Administrative Services Director for the City. Thirty-plus applications were received, of which a significant number are qualified candidates. The recruiter has been conducting telephone interviews with candidates and doing preliminary background research. A meeting will be held next week with the Director of Human Resources and the City Manager to go over the recruiter's notes and to select a group of semi-finalists

who will be brought in for interviews later in the month of May. We hope to have a selection made by mid-June with a candidate starting as soon thereafter as is practical.




