<u>Update</u>

On 05/20/14 the suspect in the incident that occurred in the 900 block of 10th St., Christopher Rutherford, 40 years, Beloit was discharged from Mercy Hospital in Janesville. Upon his discharge, Rutherford was arrested for the following:



1st Degree Reckless Homicide Felony Fleeing Resulting in Death An Arrest Warrant / Commitment – Theft

Rutherford was transported directly to the Rock County Jail. It is expected that Rutherford will make his initial court appearance tomorrow.

Officer Involved Shooting portion of the Homicide that occurred in the 900 block of 10th

The officer involved shooting portion of the overall incident is being investigated by the Wisconsin Department of Justice – Division of Criminal Investigations (DCI). The officers involved remain reassigned to an administrative assignment within our Division of Support Services until after we are able to review all the circumstances related to the shooting. This reassignment is consistent with protocol in officer involved shooting incidents.

However with the Rutherford arrest and subsequent court appearance the names of the officers involved in shooting portion of the investigation are being released. The officers involved were:
