 Meetings and Community Events (page 3) each line item accurately reflects only the allocations needed for the coming fiscal year. Most of the enterprise, special revenue and internal service fund budgets were balanced following this analysis and a few minor modifications.

The General Fund will require additional work as it does most years, and the City is awaiting additional information from the State's Department of Revenue before we make that final effort to balance not only the General Fund but the City's Capital Improvements Budget for 2015, as well. This review took most of four calendar days to complete, but is a very important element of management's due process each year when preparing the proposed Operating Budget, which will be submitted to Council to begin their review at the first regular City Council meeting in October, scheduled for Monday, October 6, 2014 at 7:00 p.m.

Absentee Voting In Person for the Partisan Primary Election Available Starting July 28, 2014

July 18, 2014 – Beloit, WI: Beginning Monday, July 28, 2014, electors registered to vote in the City of Beloit may cast an absentee ballot in person for the August 12, 2014 Partisan Primary Election. Electors who are not registered to vote and those who need to change their names and/or addresses must bring proof of residence to register. Please find the acceptable forms of proof of residence on the following page.

Late registration and absentee voting in person will be available from Monday, July 28th through Friday, August 8th in the City Clerk's office on the second floor of City Hall. Electors who would like an absentee ballot mailed to them must make the request in writing via email to lemirer@beloitwi.gov; via mail to 100 State Street, Beloit, WI 53511; or in person at the City Clerk's office.

Photo identification or other proof of identity will **not** be required to obtain an absentee ballot or to obtain a regular ballot on Election Day at the polling place for this Election. Sample ballots are available in the Document Center on the City's website www.beloitwi.gov in the Voting and Election Documents folder.

ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF PROOF OF RESIDENCE

One of the following is required to register to vote in the Clerk's office during the closed registration period or on Election Day at the Polling Place:

- A current and valid Wisconsin driver's license
- A current and valid Wisconsin identification card
- Any other Official ID Card or license issued by a Wisconsin Governmental body
- An ID card with your photo issued by an employer during the normal course of business (not including a business card)
- A real estate tax bill or receipt (for the current year or year before the election
- A residential lease which is effective for a period that includes Election Day
- A university, college, or technical college identification card (must include photo) together with a fee payment receipt issued to the cardholder by the university, college or technical college dated no earlier than 9 months before the date of the election at which the receipt is presented
- A utility bill for a period starting no earlier than 90 days before Election Day
- A bank statement or current pay check
- A government check or any other official document issued by a unit of government

NOTE: all of the above must contain a current and complete name, including both first and last name; and a current and complete residential address, including numbered street address, if any, and the name of the municipality. If the form has an expiration date, it must be valid on Election Day. **An individual may not register or vote without one of the above forms of proof of residence.**

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) has scheduled a public involvement meeting to present information and gather public comments for the reconstruction of the I-39/90 and I-43/WIS 81 Interchange in Rock County. The meeting is scheduled from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Tuesday, August 5, 2014 in the Community Room of the Beloit Public Library, located at 605 Eclipse Boulevard, Beloit, WI 53511. The meeting will be an open house format with a brief presentation at 5:30 p.m.

As part of the environmental process, the presentation will show the preferred interchange alternative. Exhibit details will include:

- An overview of the interchange depicting free flow Interstate to Interstate movements along with an extension of WIS 81 to the east;
- Intersection alternatives including stop signs, traffic signals, and roundabouts;
- Anticipated right of way needs for properties within the interchange footprint.

You are encouraged to attend the meeting, provide input, and ask questions regarding this project. WisDOT and design representatives from AECOM will be available to discuss the project
