Shooting – 500 block 8th

On 08/07/14 at approximately 1220am officers from the Beloit Police Department were dispatched to the 500 block of 8th Street in the City of Beloit for a report of a man down that possibly had been shot.

Upon arrival, officers located a single individual lying on the sidewalk suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. This subject was transported by the Beloit Fire Department to Mercy Hospital in Janesville where he is being treated for life threatening injuries.

Beloit Police Evidence Technicians were on scene throughout the night. The area has now been reopened to the public.

An update will be issued later today as the investigation progresses and the subject is positively identified.
