Shooting - 200 Block of Middle St. Beloit

On 09/27/14 at approximately 940pm, officers from the City of Beloit Police Department were dispatched to a report of an individual down in the roadway near the intersection of Bluff and Middle in the City of Beloit. Dispatch further indicated that this individual was reported to have been shot.

Upon arrival units located an individual in the roadway that appeared to have received a gunshot wound to the head. Beloit Fire EMS arrived and transported the subject to Mercy Hospital in Janesville. The subject was later taken UW Hospital in Madison with life threatening injuries.

The individual has been identified as Thomas Freese, W/M, 27 years of age, from Beloit.

Responding officers were able to determine the incident had occurred a short distance away in the roadway in the 200 block of Middle. Beloit Police Evidence Technicians and Detectives have been in working the incident throughout the night. The investigation is ongoing.
