Shooting: Randall and Porter

On 01/19/15 at 145pm an officer from the City of Beloit was on a call for service when he heard shots being fired in the area of Randall and Porter. The officer responded to the area and located three male subjects that were suffering from gunshot injuries. Beloit Fire Paramedics responded and transported two subjects to area hospitals. The third subject ran from the scene but was located in the 1200 block of Copeland. He was also transported to an area hospital.

Beloit Police Evidence Technicians are currently on the scene.

Beloit Police Detectives have spoken with witnesses at the scene and are currently at the hospitals to speak with individuals there.

The initial officer that responded was bitten in the leg by a dog while he was attempting to render aid. That officer is at Beloit Memorial Hospital receiving treatment.
