#### **CURRENT EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES**

#### **BELOIT INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL A MAJOR SUCCESS**

The expanded schedule for the Beloit International Film Festival seems to have been a major success. Preliminary numbers indicate that participation was up and many films played to sold out audiences. There was standing room only at the silent film presentation on Saturday evening. Our thanks and congratulations to the BIFF Board; Rod Beaudoin, Executive Director; and all the hundreds of volunteers who have made BIFF a success.

#### POLICE DEPARTMENT STUDY

The consulting firm of Hillard Heintze will be in the City next week for some preliminary meetings prior to the start of the Police Department's study and analysis recently authorized by City Council. They are still finalizing dates for the initial round of meetings and interviews, which will likely occur later this month.

#### I-39/90/I-43 RECONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Plans are now being finalized to submit the EA report to the Federal Highway Administration. We have another meeting of the planning committee next week to receive a full update on project activities.

#### **BELOIT TRANSIT DEVELOPMENT PLAN**

The Beloit Transit System is in the process of developing a five-year plan. The primary goals of the plan are to:

- Evaluate existing BTS service, as well as local population and employment characteristics
- Identify service needs and opportunities for improvement or expansion
- Develop alternatives that improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the system

## CITY MANAGER TO ATTEND WINTER WISCONSIN CITY/COUNTY MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION CONFERENCE

The City Manager will be gone for a portion of this week, attending the City Manager's Association Winter Conference in Pewaukee. In addition to a business meeting, a number of educational sessions are scheduled for Thursday and Friday.

#### SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Because of the press of business, City Council will hold a **Special City Council Meeting** on **Monday, March 9, 2015 at 6:30** p.m. in the City Hall Forum. (agenda attached)

2 & 3. The agenda will include creation of a governing Board of Directors and Officers for the Gateway Business Park Association, as well as a Review Board for the Gateway Business Park Association. The organization was created some time ago but since our private sector partner, MLG, owned most of the land, it was never activated. In 2012, the City bought out MLG's interest and among other things, became the declarant to appoint the initial board and the Board of Review related to Business Park activities. The primary purpose of the meeting will be to deal with a series of variances needed from the original covenants, which were created at the time the park was established and recorded to run with title to the land. The initial concept for the park was somewhat different and there are use restrictions that could impact the Pratt Industries project. There are also some height and area restrictions in the covenants which are more restrictive than City Ordinance standards. Many of those need to be waived in order for this project to go to construction. The actual waivers themselves will be considered by the Board of Review at a later meeting; however, as declarant, the "City" (meaning the City Council) must appoint these two boards so that the review process can begin.

It should also be noted that the waivers will not impact any City of Beloit Ordinances relative to land use and/or site or building plan review. The waivers will have the effect of eliminating development standards that were in excess of the City Code that could adversely impact the Pratt Industries proposed development.

4. The City's current contract for Solid Waste Disposal Services is set to expire on September 30, 2015. In searching for alternatives (there are very limited disposal options within a reasonable distance of the City of Beloit), discussions were opened with the City of Janesville, which operates a landfill in close proximity to the City of Beloit. Those negotiations were deemed successful by staff in that we received a much better price for disposal of our solid waste than we are getting from our current disposal site. Further, the distance is much closer to the City, generating a savings in the cost of time and hauling to access this disposal facility. This proposal and a staff analysis will be presented to the City Council at this meeting for their review and discussion. While this is a good deal for the City, both from a cost and proximity perspective, the City of Janesville has included in their proposal a note that they are not likely to participate in competitive bidding or Request for Proposal processes against private sector disposal sites. Consequently, if the City wishes to take advantage of this offer and the savings that it would generate, that would be done through an Intergovernmental Agreement as authorized by State law. If Council concurs with the proposal, an IGA will be drafted and submitted to Council, probably in April for final action.
