Sex Assault

On March 31, 2015 officers from the City of Beloit began an investigation regarding a sexual assault that was reported to have occurred at an apartment complex in the 1000 block of Pleasant Avenue in the City of Beloit. The investigation determined that the suspect had made arrangements through a social media web site to meet the victim at the apartment complex. During this meeting the suspect represented himself as a police officer and sexually assaulted the victim.

On April 8th, a search warrant was obtained and served at the suspect's residence to gather evidence of this crime. The suspect was identified as Kelsey Kenney, 29 years of age, from Beloit. Kenney was arrested for 3rd Degree Sexual Assault, Impersonating a Police Officer, and Soliciting Prostitution. Kenney was transported and held at the Rock County Jail.
