### Sexual Assault – UPDATE Turtle Creek Floodplain

On 04/14/15 a juvenile female subject reported to police that she had been sexually assaulted in the Turtle Creek Floodplain near the Kolak Educational Center by an unknown assailant.

On 04/17/15 the juvenile female subject was interviewed again as part of the continuing investigation. During this interview the juvenile female subject indicated that she had provided false information during her initial and subsequent interviews with law enforcement. The juvenile female subject has now provided investigators with the identity of the male subject, stated that the two of them are acquaintances, and that they had walked to the floodplain together.

The circumstances of what exacting transpired between the juvenile female and the male subject remain under investigation.
