Stabbing – 1500 block of Wisconsin

On 05/03/15 at 343pm. a RCSO Deputy patrolling near the corner of Wisconsin at Harvey was approached by an unidentified individual reporting that someone had been stabbed at 1519 Wisconsin Ave. Beloit Police responded to the home and found Shawndell Summerville, 44 years of age, Beloit, suffering stab wounds to the back and the arm. Beloit Fire Department Paramedics responded and transported Summerville to an area hospital for life threatening injuries.

Investigation determined that the suspect was Olton Dumas, 58 years of age, Beloit. Summerville and Dumas were known to each other. Law Enforcement Officers were given Dumas's information and he was quickly located in the area of Keeler and Wisconsin.

Dumas (pictured below) was arrested for: Attempted First degree Homicide, Possession of Cocaine, and Possession of drug paraphernalia. Dumas was held at the Rock County Jail.



Detectives assisted with this ongoing investigation.
