The Beloit Police Department will be at the Merrill Community Center to answer questions about police recruitment on May 18, 2015, between 5:00pm and 7:00pm. This is an opportunity to meet law officers who are working in our community to discuss law enforcement and your career. If you are thinking about applying for a job as a police officer in Beloit, we encourage you to stop by to say hello. If you have ever thought about being a police officer in Beloit, please consider stopping by to discuss a law enforcement career with these officers.

The Beloit Police Department is taking applications for police officer now through May 28, 2015. Applications are accepted on line only at the City of Beloit's website: <u>www.beloitwi.gov</u>. Applicants must possess a minimum of 45 fully accredited college level credits at the time of application and 60 fully accredited college level credits at the time of hire. All candidates must have a valid driver's license and be at least 18 years of age. Applicants cannot be convicted felons unless pardoned by the minimum standards from employment established by the Law Enforcement Standards Board of the Wisconsin Department of Justice. Candidates, after completing the Wisconsin basic law enforcement academy are preferred. Bilingual speaking candidates highly desired.
