

UPDATE: Shootings: 6th & Portland, West Grand & Brooks, Porter & Copeland

The Beloit Police Department determined that all three shooting incidents are related. Beloit Police Detectives continue to investigate the incidents and there is no ongoing or imminent threat to the community at this time. Currently five subjects have been arrested by Winnebago Co IL for charges in their jurisdiction and the Beloit Police Department, for the following:
