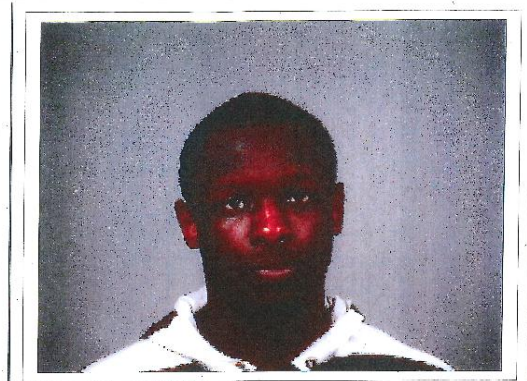
Shooting – 1800 block Shopiere Rd.

On 06/04/15 at approximately 6pm city of Beloit Police Officers were dispatched to a Gas Station / Convenience Store in the 1800 block of Shopiere Road for a report of shots being fired.

Upon arrival, officers began the investigation to determine what had occurred. Officers were notified by the 911 Center that Beloit Memorial Hospital that a gunshot victim had been taken there by private vehicle. This individual is receiving emergency medical care with life threatening injuries.

The investigation has developed a suspect. This individual has been identified as:

Ricardo Holloway, 20 years of age, from Beloit.



Holloway has a current warrant issued for his arrest on a Probation Violation. Holloway should be considered armed and dangerous.

Investigation is ongoing.
