Dear Neighbors,

The Beloit Police Department, Beloit Area Crime Stoppers, and the Beloit Fire Department will once again collaborate in the celebration of the 32nd National Night Out on Tuesday, August 4, 2015.

On August 4th from 5:30-8:30 p.m., residents in the neighborhoods throughout Beloit are asked to lock their doors, turn on and display outside lights and spend the evening outside with their neighbors. Last year over 30 neighborhood blocks registered to participate in Beloit's National Night Out celebration.

As in the past, Beloit Police Officers, Firefighters, City Officials, Beloit Area Crime Stopper Representatives and Elected Representatives will visit many of the block parties and cookouts. Each neighborhood block will be responsible for planning special activities. Barricades will be available at no cost to the neighborhoods.

National Night Out is designed to heighten crime and drug prevention awareness, as well as to generate support and participation in local anti-crime efforts. It is also a time to strengthen the neighborhood spirit and police community partnerships, and sends a message to criminals, letting them know neighborhoods are organized and are ready to fight back.

All neighborhood blocks participating in this year's National Night Out activities should register with the police department. Applications are available at the Beloit Police Department, 100 State Street, and the Beloit Fire Station Headquarters, 1111 Church Street. They can also be located on the City of Beloit's web site, www.beloitwi.gov, in the "Police Department" section.

The deadline for registration is 5:00 p.m. on July 24, 2015.

Enclosed is an application for the block parties. If you would like to participate in National Night Out, please complete the application and return it to the Beloit Police Department. We hope to have a large turn out for that evening.


