

MAN KILLED IN DRUNK DRIVING ACCIDENT

August 29, 2015—Police have arrested 29-year-old Brett R. Hundley of Clinton for Homicide by Intoxicated use of a vehicle after he allegedly struck and killed a man on a bicycle going east bound in the 2600 block of Milwaukee Rd. The accident happened around 1:50 a.m. this morning. Hundley's blood alcohol count was over the legal limit.

According to the investigation the victim did not have any lights on the bicycle and was riding in the roadway when he was struck.

"There was a Beloit citizen who saw the accident occur and stopped to give CPR to the victim," says Interim Chief David Zibolski. "It is important for citizens to help when ever possible and we commend this person for trying to assist. Unfortunately this is just another sad reminder how drinking and driving do not mix. As you are enjoying your weekend, please remember to not drink and drive and share that same message with others around you."

Beloit police detectives are working on notifying next of kin and will not release the name of the victim until then.
