#### YARD WASTE COLLECTION REMINDER—WEEK OF MAY 9—13, 2016

Yard waste will be collected the week of May 9 -13 on your regular trash day. A yard waste sticker will be required on all bags, bundles and/or containers. Yard Waste Stickers can be purchased at Walgreens, ACE Hardware, Public Works Operations Facility, City Hall Treasury, Grinnell Hall, and Leisure Services Office.

- Stickers are sold 5 to a sheet for \$7.50.
- Use only paper yard waste bags, Back-to-Nature Biodegradable bags or clean trash containers 39 gallons or less (no plastic bags).
- Yard waste containers must weigh no more than 60 pounds.
- All brush and shrubbery must be bundled, tied or contained and tagged.
- Place yard waste curbside on your regular trash day during the collection dates.
- Place yard waste 3 feet away from your regular trash.

#### CRANSTON ROAD CLOSUREAT RIVERSIDE DRIVE—WEBSITE UPDATES

The intersection of US Hwy. 51 (Riverside Drive) and Cranston Road has been under construction since April 11. The closure of Cranston Road to all traffic at that intersection will occur on May 9, 2016. A detour will be established. The project is expected to continue through August 11. This work is being done under a contract with Rock Road Companies, Inc. through the Wisconsin Department of Transportation.
