#### INTRODUCTIONS & RECAP

• Walker presented a task-level discussion of the Scope of Service and Study Area maps to help provide context for discussion.

#### FIELDWORK DESCRIPTION & UPDATE

- Walker provided a brief discussion of the field survey data collection process, various types of data collected, how it was collected, and how it will be useful in the study process.
- A map was provided for both the Rockton and City Center study areas depicting locations where parking turnover studies were requested to document length of stay.

#### ONLINE SURVEY

- Walker discussed the process for developing the online survey and approach to the survey specific to this study.
  - 1 Survey for City Center
  - 1 Survey for Rockton
  - Questions will mirror one another for these surveys but swap out study area names.
  - Cross-over questions at the end of each survey for those who visit the other study area as well.
- Collecting information related to past parking experiences, and demographics for crossreferencing responses.
- Using the draft Rockton survey as a base an open discussion led to refinement of the online survey as follows:
  - Start age at 16, in case there are respondents from the high school, etc.
  - Adjust language relating publicly owned parking vs privately owned parking.
  - Question #17 adjust language "cost" vs "free"
  - Question #18 adjust language "Pay" use our judgement
  - Question #19 remove "maybe"
  - Question #22 "worst" use opportunity
  - Change out map with revised version.
