# CITY COUNCIL MEETING-MONDAY, AUGUST 1, 2016

At 6:30 p.m. on Monday, August 1, 2016 the City Council will hold a <u>Workshop</u> in the City Manager's Conference Room to review the agenda of the 7:00 p.m. City Council meeting.

#### 4. PUBLIC HEARINGS

Resolution approving a Conditional use Permit to allow a change from one-nonconforming use to another in an R-1B, Single Family Residential District for property located at 816 Roosevelt Avenue. The application has been considered by the City Council at a previous public hearing. This will authorize the operation of a re-upholstery and decoration shop in the commercial building located at 816 Roosevelt Avenue. The Plan Commission reviewed and recommended approval (5-0-1) of the Conditional Use Permit, subject to certain conditions.

#### 6. CONSENT AGENDA

- a. Approval of the Minutes of the Regular meetings of July 5 and July 18 and Special meeting of July 25, 2016.
- b. Resolution approving the City's Offer to Purchase 106 sq. ft. of Land located at 605 Eclipse Blvd. and authorizing Execution of Same. The City originally intended to acquire the entire parcel for the Beloit Public Library; however, an error in the original survey did not include the 106 sq. ft. strip of land owned by Hendricks Commercial Properties, LLC (HCP). HCP has agreed to transfer the parcel to the City at no cost. Plan Commission reviewed and unanimously recommended for approval.
- c. Resolution awarding Public Works Contract C16-19, Bridge Sealing and Painting. This project will preserve five bridges through the application of protective coatings. Two bids were received; Waumandee Creek Sealants, LLC is the low bidder.
- d. Resolution authorizing Final Payment of Public Works Contract C15-09, Big Hill Bike Path. This project built an off road bike path from the lower playground to Big Hill Court. The work is complete and the City Engineer recommends final payment.

#### 11. REPORTS FROM BOARDS AND CITY OFFICERS

a. Resolution amending the Mutual Cooperation Agreement under the 2013 OHHLHC Healthy Homes and Lead Hazard Control Program. The Lead Grant provides funding to home owners and landlords to make their dwelling units leadsafe for children in coordination with the Rock County Health Department. The amendment would allow for Rock County funds to be allocated to the City of Beloit or the City of Janesville for additional lead projects.


