Building permit Information

The purpose of the Building Code is to provide minimum standards for the protection of life, limb, health, property, environment, and for the safety and welfare of the general public, consumers, owners and occupants of residential, commercial, industrial and public buildings. Building Code/Permits control all matters concerning the construction, alteration, addition, repair, removal, demolition, use, location, occupancy and maintenance of all buildings and structures and their service equipment and appurtenances located in the city.

Permit Applications are available **online** through the City of Beloit's website or you can apply for a permit on the **3rd floor** of City Hall Monday-Friday between the hours of 8am and 5pm.

HVAC Permits

 A licensed HVAC contractor is required for any and all HVAC work being done.

Plumbing Permits

- You do NOT need a permit for the following:
 - Repair of plumbing
 Repair/replace trap or drain
 Repair plugged drain
 Shower head replacement
 Installation of relief valve
 pipe
- You DO need a permit and a licensed, master plumber for the following:
 - Installation of new plumbing
 Replacement of toilet/sink
 Installation of water heater
 venting
 Changing a faucet
 Install dishwasher/refrigerator
 water connection

Building Permits

- You do NOT need a permit or a license for the following:
 - Flooring only, including
 - carpeting
 - Painting only
 - **Decorating only**
 - Install gutters only
 - Install roof venting only
 - Install insulation only
 - When material costs for your
 - project are less than \$1,000.
- You DO need a permit and a licensed contractor for the following:
 - New construction
 - Materials exceed \$1,000 for
 - the project:
 - Windows
 - Doors
 - Walls, ceilings, etc.
 - Siding
 - Roofing

Electrical Permits

- You do NOT need a permit for the following:
 - Replace switch plate cover only Replace electrical outlet cover only
- You do NOT need a permit, but you DO NEED a licensed electrician for the following:
 - Switching out light fixtures Capping off a light fixture, outlet, etc.
- You DO need a permit AND a licensed, master electrician for the following:
 - Installation of any NEW electrical fixtures and/or wiring Installation of GFIs

Other Permits

- ♦ Fences
 - Install a new, replace an old, or alter an existing fence
- ♦ Pools
 - Anything with a depth or 2 feet or more
- ♦ Chickens
 - Permissible with permit
