YARD WASTE REMINDER

The Public Works Department reminds residents that curbside collection of yard waste takes place on your regular trash day, August 15—18th. Place yard waste at least 3 feet away from your regular trash.

- All brush and shrubbery must be bundled, tied or contained and tagged with a yard waste sticker placed on it.
- Stickers are sold 5 to a sheet for \$7.50 and are available at Walgreens, ACE Hardware,
 Public Works Operations Facility, City Hall Treasury, Grinnell Hall, Leisure Services
 Office
- Use only paper yard waste bags, Back-to-Nature Biodegradable bags or clean trash containers 39 gallon or less. No plastic bags!
- Yard waste containers must weigh no more than 60 pounds.



BELOIT HISTORIC SIGNAGE PROJECT

The City of Beloit has a long history of successful historic preservation efforts. It has a historic downtown, over 300 locally protected buildings, and three historic districts on the National Register of Historic Places. The installation of signage identifying the City's historic districts has long been a goal of the Landmarks Commission and City staff, but has not come to fruition until now due to a lack of funding.

In the spring of 2016, the City received a grant from Visit Beloit and a generous donation from Fairbanks Morse which will

allow us to complete this project. For the past several months, the Landmarks Commission began the process of designing, choosing locations, and purchasing the identification signs for the districts. The selected signage is illustrated on the drawing. 18" X 24" signs will be installed intermittently along the blocks in the Bluff Street Historic district, Merrill Street Historic District, and Near East Side Historic District. In addition, street



sign toppers will be installed on the existing sign poles at intersections in the districts.

The goal is to have the signs installed by the end of October. Both staff and the Landmarks Commissioners are excited to see the signs finally in place after so many years of discussion and planning. The new signage will enable both residents and visitors to more easily find and take a stroll through our beautiful historic neighborhoods.

Beloit Set to Host Inaugural U.S. Kubb Open August 13th

BELOIT, Wis. (July 27, 2016) – Beloit is ready to welcome Kubb enthusiasts for the third consecutive year but with some new and exciting changes in 2016. Visit Beloit partnered with Beloit Parks and Leisure Services to create and host the Rock, Paper, Kubb Tournament in 2014 and 2015. 
