1. President Luebke called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Forum at Beloit City Hall.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

3. SPECIAL ORDERS OF THE DAY/ANNOUNCEMENTS

#### 4. PUBLIC HEARINGS

- a. Community Development Director, Julie Christensen, introduced a Resolution approving a Conditional Use Permit to allow a change from one-nonconforming use to another in an R-1B, Single Family Residential District for property located at 816 Roosevelt Avenue. The Plan Commission recommendation for approval was 5-0-1. Isaac Rojas has filed an application for a Conditional Use Permit to allow one legal non-conforming use to be changed to another legal non-conforming use for the property located at 816 Roosevelt Ave in the City of Beloit. The applicant is seeking permission to operate a re-upholstery and interior decoration business.
  - According to Section 9.2.1 of the Zoning Code (Chapter 19), a legal nonconforming use may be changed to another nonconforming use in accordance with the conditional use procedures if the new use will have a "lesser negative impact".
    - Allied Games (home amusement business selling billiard tables and darts) previously occupied the building as a legal non-conforming use in accordance with a 2009 Conditional Use Permit. The business officially ceased usage of the property in November of 2015.
  - The applicant is seeking permission to operate a re-upholstery and interior decoration business in the commercial building on the property.
    - The commercial building is adjacent to a single-family residential house on the same parcel that the applicant currently lives in.
    - o The business, Isaac Rojas Interiors, will primarily consist of drop-off/pick-up of small furniture for re-upholstery as well as consulting work. The applicant is an interior decorator by trade.
    - The applicant has indicated that the store will only be staffed by one individual (the applicant)
    - The business will serve customers by appointment only.
  - The proposed business is classified as a Retail/Sales Service Repair Oriented Use.
    - The minimum number of off-street parking spaces for the proposed use is one parking space per 500 sq. ft., or four spaces. The garage in the rear of property has three spaces and the driveway on the west side of the property has two spaces. The total number of off-street parking spaces at the property meets the requirements of the Zoning Code. The applicant will likely only utilize one or two of the available off-street spaces at one time due to the appointment-only nature of the business.
  - o Roosevelt Avenue has unlimited parking on both sides of the street in front of the property. President Luebke opened the hearing. No one spoke. President Luebke closed the hearing. Councilors De Forest and Dunkin made a motion to adopt the resolution as presented. Motion carried. File 8396

#### 5. CITIZEN PARTICIPATION

a. Lisa Tollefson, 5818 N. Kennedy Road, Milton introduced herself as the current Rock County Clerk who was appointed in June of 2015, and asked councilors and the public for their vote on August 9.

- b. Dennis Hughes, 144 N. Jefferson, Milwaukee introduced himself as a union representative who is representing a non-represented employee, Michael Wright whose employment terminated by the City while he was on medical leave. Mr. Hughes explained that he is before the council because they are the last step in the grievance process and they have not been able to obtain the hearing they are requesting from the City of Beloit. He is requesting that the City Council consider Mr. Wright's appeal and also encouraged the council to review the City's policy that eliminates just cause and requires employees to split the cost of an independent hearing with the city, causing further hardship to the employee.
- c. Michael Wright, 2179 Linway Drive, Beloit addressed the council with a grievance that claims the city falsely terminated him based on a medical condition in order to prohibit him from the right to appeal his termination through the grievance procedure. He explained he's worked for the city for 37 years and was forced to take early retirement because while out on medical leave, he received a letter from Human Resources ending his employment as an equipment operator because the city could not accommodate a medical restriction. He has followed the personnel policy procedure for appealing his termination and is before the council this evening to seek a hearing and would appreciate their consideration.

#### 9. COUNCILOR ACTIVITIES AND UPCOMING EVENTS

- Councilor De Forest thanked the Parks employees for the great maintenance of the Parks after
  walking Harpers Prairie where she found the official Beloit flower, the Purple Comb flower. As a
  member of the Downtown Business Association, she investigated two new business: The Porch and
  Mystery and Escape Quest. She encouraged others to check them out. She's looking forward to
  National Night out tomorrow and the Street Dance this weekend.
- Councilor Sloniker attended the PFC meeting. She recently learned that the street lights in Beloit are
  owned and operated by Alliant Energy but thanked a Brian and Mark of DPW for assisting with a
  neighborhood light issue recently. She offered her condolences to the family of Malachi Taylor who
  recently passed while out of the country on mission work.
- Councilor Dunkin thanked the Beloit Police Department and Fire Department for the help in the
  funeral procession of Airman 1<sup>st</sup> Class George Marion Ingram. She attended the Beloit Police
  Department listening session at Central Christian Church. She encouraged residents and visitors
  alike to attend the farmers market that runs 8am-1pm every Saturday through October 8<sup>th</sup> this year.
  She thanked Julie Christensen and Lori Luther for their vision and decisions for revitalization efforts
  on the west side of town. She too is looking forward to National Night out tomorrow and the Street
  Dance this weekend.
- Councilor Preuschl attended the stop the violence meeting and encouraged people to hear what Richard Harris has to say as he speaks an inspiring message "vision beyond bars." He encouraged all to attend the Street Dance Friday and Farmers Market this Saturday.
- Councilor Hendrix recently took 19 students to Washington DC for tour and college visits. The students represented Beloit fantastically. The step team she coaches will be performing Friday at the Street Dance.

#### 11. REPORTS FROM BOARDS AND CITY OFFICERS

- a. Community Development Director, Julie Christensen, introduced a resolution amending the Mutual Cooperation Agreement under the 2013 OHHLHC Healthy Homes and Lead Hazard Control Program. The cities of Beloit and Janesville and Rock County applied for and received a Healthy Homes and Lead Hazard Control Grant of \$2.5 million from the Department of Housing and Urban Development in 2013. We entered into a Mutual Cooperation Agreement which outlined how the funds would be allocated, record-keeping requirements, and benchmarks
  - The Lead Grant provides funding to home owners and landlords to make their dwelling units Lead safe for children in coordination with the Rock County Health Department. These funds are often used in conert with our CDBG or HOME funds on a project. This allows for the lead itmes to be funded through a Lead Grant, thereby, reducing the amount of funds a household will have to pay towards a project.
  - This amendment to the Mutual Cooperation Agreement to the Mutual Cooperation Agreement (attached) would allow for Rock County funds to be allocated to the City of Beloit or the City of Janesville for additional lead projects. Our grant deadline is January, 2017. Although Beloit has enrolled the number of housing units required under the Agreement, Rock County has not been able to fund enough projects to meet its funding commitments. The City of Beloit continues to receive referrals from the Rock County Health Department and therefore, could complete additional projects.
  - This amendment to the Agreement will also allow the modifications to the individual line items in the budget in order for the funds to get expended by the end of the grant.

#### Overview/Background Information:

Jeff Whiteman of Geronimo Hospitality Group has filed an application for a Conditional Use Permit to allow an indoor entertainment venue with beer sales & consumption in an M-2, General Manufacturing District, for a proposed golf simulation lab within the Ironworks complex located at 625-701 Third Street.

#### **Key Issues (maximum of 5):**

- The proposed golf simulation lab is approximately 8,000 square-feet in area, and will include digital simulators, a putting surface, a driving range, and a lobby/bar area near the entrance from the new "spine" roadway.
- The proposed facility will be open to the public, and will utilize a shared corridor with ADA access and bathrooms as shown on the attached floor plan.
- The proposed use is classified as "Entertainment-Oriented Retail Sales/Service," which requires a Conditional Use Permit to operate in an M-2, General Manufacturing District.
- The application and the overall floor plan for the central portion of Ironworks are also attached to this report.

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





#### Overview/Background Information:

Hawks Ridge Apartments has submitted an application for an amendment to the PUD, Master Land Use Plan for the property located at 1750 Gateway Blvd.

#### **Key Issues:**

- The applicant has proposed the construction of two 4-story apartment buildings and one 3-story apartment building on the site of the existing Hawk's Ridge Apartments.
- The original PUD plan approved in 2004 proposed the construction of ten 32-unit buildings (six of which were built as Phase 1).
- Three proposed buildings with a total of 208 additional units will be built in place of the four 32-unit buildings that were originally part of Phase 2 and never constructed.
- A two-lot CSM submitted by the applicant is being considered concurrently with the PUD application and would divide the existing Hawks Ridge Apartments parcel into two separate lots for financing purposes.
- A copy of the original PUD Master Land Use Plan Resolution is attached to this report.







Part of the Southeast ¼ of the Northwest ¼ of Section 28, Township 1 North, Range 13 East of the 4th P.M., City of Beloit, Rock County, Wisconsin, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: Commencing at the East-Quarter corner of Section 28 aforesaid; thence North 88°46'44" West along the East-West centerline of said Section 28 a distance of 3446.20 feet to the Northwesterly right-of-way of Gateway Boulevard; thence North 30°52'47" East along said right-of-way 680.46 feet to the Northeasterly corner of Lot One of Certified Survey Map Document No. 1600107 as recorded in Volume 26, Pages 72 – 74 of Rock County Certified Survey Maps; thence North 88°46'44" West 916.33 feet to the Northwest corner of said Lot One; thence North 0°58'26" West, 738.96 feet; thence South 88°38'55" East 1344.36 feet to the Northwesterly right-of-way of Gateway Boulevard; thence South 30°52'47" West 791.14 feet along said right-of-way to the point of beginning. Containing 19.273 acres, more or less.

As a condition of granting the Planned Unit Development (PUD) Master Land Use Plan, the City Council does hereby stipulate the following conditions and restrictions upon the development which are hereby deemed necessary for the public interest:

- Ten, 32-unit multifamily apartment buildings with up to 320 dwelling units, including a clubhouse, swimming pool and fitness center, shall be permitted on subject property if development substantially conforms to the approved Master Land Use Plan submitted with this application and all of the required conditions.
- 2. This development shall be constructed according to the approved detailed PUD Final Plan submitted to and approved by the City Zoning Officer prior to issuance of any building permits.
- 3. Roadway access to Gateway Boulevard shall be as indicated on the PUD Final Plan or as otherwise approved by the City Engineer.
- 4. The PUD Final Plan shall include a looped access drive to provide easy emergency access in and through the site and if this project is constructed in phases then a temporary turn around shall be constructed at the end of any access drive that results in a dead-end.

- 5. The PUD Final Plan shall include a looped water system with the number and location of fire hydrants provided and installed as approved by the City Zoning Officer.
- 6. The developer shall include sidewalks in the PUD Final Plan and these sidewalks shall be constructed as per the approved PUD Final Plan as each building is constructed if this development is constructed in two or more phases.
- 7. The developer shall construct concrete driveway aprons at their access drives and a public concrete sidewalk, five-foot wide, along the entire lot frontage in the Gateway Boulevard rightof-way at the same time as construction of Gateway Boulevard extension is performed.
- 8. Monies in lieu of parkland dedication shall be paid to the City's Parkland Dedication Fund in the amount of \$46,665.60 (320 x 145.83) prior to issuance of the first building permit for construction on this lot, or as otherwise determined by the Park, Recreation & Conservation Advisory Commission.
- 9. The Plan Commission and City Council shall approve any major changes in the adopted conditions or use of this property. The Community Development Director may approve minor changes administratively and allow accessory structures and uses that comply with and meet all of these standards.

#### Overview/Background Information:

Steve Manteufel has requested attachment to the City of Beloit for his property located at 2028 E. Ridge Road in the Town of Turtle. A failing septic system is the impetus for this attachment request.

#### **Key Issues:**

- This property is located within the 208 Sewer Service Area and the City of Beloit extended sanitary sewer service several years ago.
- This property is not located within the Boundary Adjustment Area designated in the <u>Cooperative Boundary Plan</u> <u>between the City of Beloit and the Town of Turtle.</u> However, the Boundary Agreement governs this property stating "if the sanitary septic system on a property in a Town island fails and the Rock County Health Department determines that the septic system cannot be repaired or replaced, the property owner may petition the City of Beloit to attach to the City for the purpose of obtaining City sewer service."
- The attached Plat shows the location of the subject property on the southeast side of E Ridge Road between E Ridge Road and Milwaukee Road. The Plat includes the rights-of-way for both streets at the request of the City Engineer.





**COMES NOW** Captain Dan Molland, being first duly sworn and upon oath respectfully makes the following allegations against the license holder listed above:

- 1. The Complainant is Captain Dan Molland of the City of Beloit Police Department, 100 State Street, Beloit, WI 53511 and a resident of the City of Beloit.
- 2. Casey's Marketing Company, d/b/a Casey's General Store #3316, Emma Monheim, Agent, 2350 Cranston Road, is the holder of the attached Class "A" Fermented Malt Beverage license issued for the period of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017 and the license and application are attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and **Exhibit 2**.
- 3. The abridged minutes of the June 14, 2016 meeting of the City of Beloit Alcohol Beverage License Control Committee are attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and incorporated herein by reference. Said minutes document the appearance of the license holder before the committee to address the sale of alcohol to an underage person on May 4, 2016. Said minutes document the committee's recommendation of a consecutive 10-day suspension of said license.
- 4. The abridged minutes of the December 8, 2015 meeting of the City of Beloit Alcohol Beverage License Control Committee are attached hereto as **Exhibit 4** and incorporated herein by reference. Said minutes document the appearance of the license holder before the committee to address the sale of alcohol to an underage person on November 30, 2015.
- 5. As grounds for the sanction, it is alleged that the licensed holder violated Chapter 125 or municipal regulations adopted under §125.10, Wis. Stats. Specifically, it is alleged that the license holder sold alcohol to an underage person on November 30, 2015 and again on May 4, 2016 contrary to §31.01 of the Code of General Ordinances for the City of Beloit, which adopts § 125.07(1)(a), Wis. Stats., and that said violations were committed within a 12 month period of time. ISR numbers BE1618851 and BE1561204 document the police department investigation into these incidents, and are attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Exhibit 5** and **Exhibit 6**.

- 6. City of Beloit Municipal Court records indicate that Jason Grzelak, was issued Citation D7804X4FC9 alleging sale of alcohol to an underage person for an incident occurring on the licensed premises on November 30, 2015. Said records further indicate that Grzelak was convicted of said offense on January 7, 2016. A Certificate of Conviction in Beloit Municipal Court for citation number D7804X4FC9 is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as **Exhibit 7**.
- 7. City of Beloit Municipal Court records indicate that Rustin Roth, was issued Citation D7804TNC5G alleging sale of alcohol to an underage person for an incident occurring on the licensed premises on May 4, 2016. Said records further indicate that Roth was convicted of said offense on June 2, 2016. A Certificate of Conviction in Beloit Municipal Court for citation number D7804TNC5G is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as **Exhibit 8**.
- 8. In addition to the incidents described above, the City reserves the right to rely on evidence, if any, arising out of any further violations at or about the premises complained of up to the time of any hearing held herein.
- 9. By reason of the foregoing acts and omissions of the license holder, Casey's Marketing Company, d/b/a Casey's General Store #3316, the ABLCC recommends to the City Council that the license be <u>suspended for a period of 10 days</u> beginning forthwith and running for 10 consecutive days.

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Tom Lindaas, Store Manager for the Tobacco Shack appeared on behalf of the owner/agent. Captain Risse reviewed the process for compliance checks and explained the incident at this premise. Captain Risse asked Mr. Lindaas to explain what the store has done to change procedures so this doesn't occur again. Mr. Lindaas explained that all employees are going through recertification and they are placing an emphasis on training throughout the store. The employee is a valued employee and was suspended for 30 days and is paying the fines. Captain Risse asked if their registers allow for entry of a birthdate or a scanner that checks ID. He answered that they don't have such technology and they are dependent on training and checking for proper ID. He has appeared before the committee twice in ten years and they take these violations very seriously. Ms. Tinder asked if the store considered investing in technology that checks ID so the error isn't as likely to occur. Mr. Baskin went on record to state he was pleased this employee was not terminated as we are human and we make errors.

This is the first violation in a calendar year and no recommendation for sanction is being made by staff at this time.

13. Consideration of an incident May 4, 2016, at Rollette Oil Co. #1, 1451 Madison Road, Paul R. Simon, Agent for a sale to an underage person during an alcohol compliance check.

Paul R. Simon appeared as owner/agent for the store. Captain Risse reviewed the process for compliance checks and explained the incident at this premise. Captain Risse asked Mr. Simon to explain what the store has done to change procedures so this doesn't occur again. Mr. Simon explained that they have a strict policy that if you sell to minors, you are terminated. This employee was relieved of her duties immediately and has since hired an attorney to fight the ticket under the defense of entrapment. Their registers have the function to enter the birthdate but only if they ring the sale as alcohol. This employee rang the sale as tobacco and therefore was not required to enter a date of birth. It is not clear if that was intentional or not.

This is the first violation in a calendar year and no recommendation for sanction is being made by staff at this time.

14. Consideration of an incident May 4, 2016, at Casey's General Store #3316, 2350 Cranston Road, Emma Monheim, Agent for a sale to an underage person during an alcohol compliance check. (2<sup>nd</sup> offense within 12 months).

Ms. Monheim appeared as agent for the store. Captain Risse reviewed the process for compliance checks and explained the incident at this premise. Captain Risse explained that in November after the first violation he received a 3-page list of changes the store was implementing to make sure it doesn't happen again. He asked if those changes have been implemented. Ms. Monheim answered that to her knowledge they were not and she has been the store's agent for one month. Since she's come on board, they have retrained on the policies, are checking ID for anyone appearing to be under 30 years of age, making certain employees know how to scan the ID on the register and check ID's properly, and this employee no longer works for the company.

Captain Risse explained that this is the second violation within a six month period and recommendations for sanctions have been consistent with past practice. The Police Department is recommending a 10-day license suspension. Mr. Tilley asked if they would have to physically

remove alcohol or just lock it up. Attorney Krueger explained that the alcohol would have to be locked away and made unavailable for sale.

Tilley and Tinder made a motion to accept the recommendation of a 10-day suspension for this second violation within 12 months. Motion carried 6-1 with Baskin voting no.

Attorney Krueger explained that with this recommendation, she will draft a formal complaint which will be introduced to the City Council and then a date for a hearing would be set. The store then has the opportunity to have an attorney present to represent them at the hearing. Attorney Krueger encouraged the Casey's to obtain an attorney and will make contact with Ms. Monheim or the company's attorney to explain when the hearing is set to take place.

15. Consideration of noise complaints against The Tavern, 1567 Madison Road, Susan Hudson, Agent.

Susan Hudson, Agent and Patricia Mitchell appeared to represent the establishment. Captain Risse explained that an officer was dispatched to the establishment after a citizen complaint was made at the May 10 meeting. The office reported that upon arriving he did not notice any loud music outside and there was no alcohol being consumed in the smoking area. The doors were not propped open and music could only be heard upon reaching the front doors. The officer advised the staff of the complaint and the staff stated they would do their best in maintaining these issues.

Captain Risse followed up with the citizen making the complaint and he explained that since the change in ownership he has noticed an improvement and does not have current issues with the establishment. Ms. Hudson made it clear that they would be more than willing to share contact information with Mr. Parish so he can contact them anytime he notices an issue. They take pride in the business and want to be good neighbors by respecting the neighborhood.

- 16. City Clerk Stottler informed the committee that currently one Reserve license is available for sale. The Local closed and did not reapply so a second Reserve license will become available July 1. She explained her attempts to contact the parties responsible at Pitcher's Mound and has been unsuccessful. She reminded the committee that in November of 2015 they approved recommendation for a liquor license to Peter Gabrielle of Palermo's and that license did not issue in the current license year. He has applied for renewal and the committee has approved recommendation as well as council approval on June 6, 2016. According to City Ordinance 31.04(3), "Where the City Council has granted a license, but the license has not been issued because construction, renovation or code compliance is not completed in 6 months, the City Council may rescind the license at a regular Council meeting after notice to the licensee and opportunity for the licensee to be heard." The committee would like to have Mr. Gabrielle added to the July agenda for him to give an update on the construction and timeline for opening for business.
- 17. Citizen Comments: Danny Hatch, Jr. from the Alumni wanted to follow up with the committee to make sure that he has met all of the requirements to sell the business. Attorney Krueger explained that Mr. Davis has been granted a license today and upon approval June 20, 2016 he no longer has the license since it is granted to Mr. Davis.

Rao Mudabir Ahmed with ND Gas wanted to inform the committee that after listening to some of the concerns for selling to minors and some registers not having a scanning function, that there

Baskin made a motion to have the two CVS stores put on the January 12th agenda, second by Mr. Metter. Motion carried.

- f. Casey's General Store #3316, 2350 Cranston Road Jeffrey Kimberly, Janesville, WI appeared representing Casey's General Store #3316. Captain Risse stated the operative was able to purchase alcohol without showing identification. Mr. Kimberly said the store policy is to scan ID into the register, not manually enter birthdate, for all customers looking under 40 years old. Mr. Kimberly said the employee was terminated for not following corporate policy. Mr. Kimberly explained that all employees are going through a complete retraining and that the termination of the employee was an example for the whole staff. Attorney Krueger reminded Mr. Kimberly that if there is a second violation within twelve months it would likely result in sanctions.
- 5. Citizens Comments: None
- 6. Committee Comments: Chairman Berkley thanked Captain Risse for the eleven month comprehensive report of police calls in the City.
- 7. Police Department Comments: Captain Risse explained that he will have a thirty day report for this committee listing the police calls for service. Chairman Berkley asked how many calls are considered excessive and Captain Risse stated each report is evaluated on its own merits. Chairman Berkley asked about the public parking lots that are used by businesses and who is responsible for the cleanup. Captain Risse stated the owners check the parking lots themselves and conduct a cleanup.
- 8. At 4:30 p.m. Dr. Baskin made a motion to adjourn, second by Mr. Tilley. Motion carried.

On Wednesday, May 4, 2016, I Sergeant Andre Sayles gave briefing regarding a Alcohol Compliance check that I was putting on for the City of Beloit. I made contact with City Attorney Beth Krueger and informed of her this matter. Attorney Krueger issued to me a immunity letter for the underage youth to take part in this matter. I issued a copy of this to the underage purchasers.

Once I completed my briefing, I made contact with Abigail Draeving and Frederick Sennett, 09/1996. I positively identified both by their Wisconsin Driver Licenses. I took a photo copy of both for my records. I then conducted a pat down of the both to assure they only had the one identification card on them. I then took a digital photo of them to show that their appearance had not been altered in anyway to make them look older than they are.

During this operation, I was accompanied by Officer Brian Miller to issue the possible citations.

At 1647 hours, I pulled into the parking lot of 2350 Cranston Rd, which is associated with the Casey's General Store. I had both Abigail and Frederick exit the vehicle I was driving. I issued them both \$20. I gave them directions. I monitored both as they walked into the front door, which faces north toward Cranston Rd. As I waited, and watched the door, I observed at approximately 1649 hours, both exit the store. I observed that Frederick was carrying a plastic bag. Frederick got into the vehicle and told me that he was able to purchase a six (6) pack of Blue Moon beer from a female white, who was standing at the register and was on the left.

I then radioed to Officer Miller, who had been parked around the coroner. Once officer Miller arrived, I had Frederick exit the car. I then took a photo of him holding the alcohol. I turned over the Blue Moon to Officer Miller and also the change from the purchase.

Myself and officer Miller walked into the store and made contact with a female white, who Officer Miller identified as Rustin D Roth, During the interaction Roth, she immediately stated that she had messed up and sold the alcohol to the student.

Roth citation number is D7804TNC5G. Court date of 6/2/16 at 0830.

Officer Miller then issued Roth her citation and explained it to her. Officer Miller also took a finger print from Roth. The finger print is attached to this narrative.

Officer Miller did retrieve the \$10 that was used to purchase the Bud Light.

Prior to leaving the store grounds, I conducted another search of Frederick and assured he did not have any items on his person.





Notice to the retailer 72 hours after the sting on the results.

Purchaser can't be a "regular customer" of the retailer.

Purchaser must give true age if asked, cannot lie.

Purchaser must be under the age of 21 years of age.

The procedure was to have an Officer transport the underage purchaser to the place of business and provide money to buy beer. One Officer in plain clothes will maintain surveillance on the purchaser during the controlled buy. Upon exiting, the purchaser will advise the Officer who sold them the intoxicant and provide a description of the clerk.

The second Officer (Uniformed) will then photograph the purchaser with the beer and make contact with the suspect. A citation will be issued to the clerk who sold the beer and check for a license holder is on the premise.

The purchasers were checked in reference to the compliance issues and photographed. All purchasers had their Wisconsin / Illinois identification / Driver's license card on them.

At approximately 1715 hours, I transported the purchaser David M Cliffe DOB: 09/1/95 to Casey's General Store located at 2350 Cranston Rd in the City of Beloit. At approximately 1718 hours, I gave David the buy money (20.00 Dollars bill) and he entered into the store. I observed David walk up to the register with a green box. The clerk was a male white wearing a black colored shirt. The clerk made contact with David and completed the purchase. At approximately 1720 hours, David exited the store with the green box. On the box is the brand name "Heineken" which is an alcohol beverage. David had the change from the purchase. I photographed David with the alcohol beverage purchased.

Officer Halvorsen of the Beloit Police Department arrived on scene in uniform. David gave a description of the clerk who sold him the beer to Officer Halvorsen. 

COMPLAINT

**COMES NOW** Captain Dan Molland, being first duly sworn and upon oath respectfully makes the following allegations against the license holder listed above:

- 1. The Complainant is Captain Dan Molland of the City of Beloit Police Department, 100 State Street, Beloit, WI 53511 and a resident of the City of Beloit.
- 2. Pitcher's Mound Ltd, LLC, 2745 Prairie Avenue, Beloit, WI, is the holder of the attached approved, but not issued, Combination Class B Intoxicating Liquor and Fermented Malt Beverage license issued for the period of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017 and the license and application are attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and **Exhibit 2**.
- 3. The abridged minutes of the June 14, 2016 meeting of the City of Beloit Alcohol Beverage License Control Committee are attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and incorporated herein by reference. Said minutes document the committee's recommendation of a revocation of said license.
- 4. As grounds for the sanction, it is alleged that the licensed holder violated Chapter 125 or municipal regulations adopted under §125.10, Wis. Stats. Specifically, it is alleged that the license holder has abandoned the license for a period of 90 days, contrary to §31.18 of the Code of General Ordinances for the City of Beloit which states as follows:

### "31.18 - ABANDONMENT OF LICENSE.

The closing of any licensed premises for a continuous period of 90 days shall be deemed abandonment of the license, and such license shall be forfeited upon notice in writing by registered mail to the licensee by the City Clerk. If the premises are damaged by fire or other cause, the City Council may extend the closing to allow for reconstruction".

5. On April 15 2016, Pitcher's Mound applied for a renewal of the Combination Class B license. On May 3, 2016, Pitcher's Mound closed its doors. A screenshot of Mr. Lewis' Facebook page that acknowledges that the Pitcher's Mound was closed and looking for new owners is attached hereto as **Exhibit 4** and incorporated herein by reference. During the renewal process, the business was closed

and not made available to inspection personnel. Mr. Lewis has failed to respond to numerous inquiries by city staff and has not contacted the City of Beloit in any way regarding his license.

- In addition to the incidents described above, the City reserves the right to rely on evidence, if any, arising out of any further violations at or about the premises complained of up to the time of any hearing held herein. Pitcher's Mound Ltd LLC
- By reason of the foregoing acts and omissions of the license holder Pitcher's Mound, the ABLCC recommends to the City Council that the license be <u>revoked</u>.
