## Beloit City Hall Opens Additional Hours for In-Person Absentee Voting

October 26, 2016 - In-Person Absentee Voting, sometimes called "early voting" is currently being offered at Beloit City Hall on the first floor during business hours (Monday – Friday 8:00am – 5:00pm).

There will also be three extended hour opportunities to vote in-person absentee in the City of Beloit for those who require evening or weekend hours:

- Wednesday, October 26th until 7:30 p.m.
- Saturday, October 29<sup>th</sup> 9:00 am until noon
- Wednesday, November 2<sup>nd</sup> until 7:30 p.m.

All in-person absentee voting will end by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, November 4<sup>th</sup> – no voting will be available November 5<sup>th</sup> through Monday, November 7<sup>th</sup>.

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may request to vote an absentee ballot. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen, who will be 18 years of age or older on Election Day, who has resided in the ward or municipality where he or she wishes to vote for at least **10** consecutive days before the election. The elector must also be registered in order to receive an absentee ballot. Proof of identification must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued.
