The purpose of the meeting is to share the results of recently completed Intensive Survey Report that recommends the establishment of a new historic district known as the Milwaukee Road & Emerson Street Historic District. City and WHS staff will also be able to answer questions or concerns about this process. All City Councilors have been invited and a quorum may be present although no official action will be taken.
