HISTORIC DISTRICT IDENTIFICATION SIGN PROJECT COMPLETE

The Beloit Landmarks Commission announced that the historic district identification sign project is complete. In the spring of 2016, the City secured the funding necessary to move forward with this project. Thanks to a grant from Visit Beloit and a generous donation from Fairbanks Morse, the Landmarks Commission began the process of designing, choosing locations for, and purchasing the identification signs for the districts. The Bluff Street Historic District, Merrill Street Historic District, and Near East Side Historic District now have rectangular signs that are spaced intermittently along blocks and street sign toppers on the existing street signs at intersections. The new signage will enable residents and visitors to more easily find and stroll through our beautiful historic neighborhoods.
