Overview/Background Information:

Karla P. Robledo Mendoza, the President and agent for Los Corrales Restaurant, LLC is applying for the license. This is a new owner at 946 Wisconsin Avenue (formerly Victoria Rose LLC who held a Class "B" Beer and Class "C" wine license for the current license year). Because there are not quota limits on Class "B" licenses any new applicant will require new consideration and if approved receives a new license. Given the close proximity to the renewal deadline of April 15th, if approved, a license will be issued that is only good through June 30, 2017, the applicant will need to immediately file for renewal for the July 1 2017 through June 30, 2018 license period.

Key Issues (maximum of 5):

- 1. This business (formerly Victoria Rose) is located at 946 Wisconsin Avenue, in the City of Beloit.
- 2. Karla P. Robledo Mendoza is applying for a Class "B" Beer license. The applicant has been provided the DOR Pub 302 and other documentation on applying for a liquor license and understanding the responsibility that comes with the application.
- 3. Ms. Robledo Mendoza has completed the necessary paperwork with the WI DOR and has supplied my office with a complete application for the referral and consideration by the ABLCC and the City Council.
- 4. The ABLCC will review this application at their April 11th regular meeting.



Overview/Background Information:

Whitney L. Walraven has applied for an Alcohol Beverage Operator's (Bartender's) License on February 21, 2017. She completed an application, showed proof of completion of Safe Server Beverage Course, presented a satisfactory ID and paid the application fee. Her application was forwarded to the Beloit Police Department for review and recommendation. Captain Risse submitted a memorandum to the Clerk's Office on February 28, 2017 denying her request for a license due to the convictions found during her background investigation. A review of Walraven's record shows the following:

The City sent a letter to Walraven on March 2, 2017 informing her of the denial. Walraven sent an email objecting to the denial to Captain Risse on March 10, 2017. Captain Risse did not recommend changing the Department's recommendation for denial Walraven had opted to appeal the denial. Walraven submitted her written appeal on March 31, 2017.

Key Issues (maximum of 5):

- 1. Walraven applied for an operator's license on February 21, 2017.
- 2. The Police Department conducted an investigation of her background and has recommended denial of the license due to 2 Operating While Under the Influence convictions in the State of Illinois.
- 3. Walraven has chosen to appeal this determination and submitted her appeal.
- 4. The application for an operator's license is before the ABLCC for a recommendation to the City Council.
- 5. See attached guidance from the League of Wisconsin Municipalities for standard of review for alcohol beverage licenses.

Action required/Recommendation:

Recommendation to the City Council to approve or deny the application

II. Retail Licenses and Permits / E. Licensee Qualifications

E. Licensee Qualifications

1. Age

Individuals, all partners (including limited partners), the officers, directors, and agents of corporations, the members, managers and agents of limited liability companies and the officers, directors and agents of nonprofit organizations must be of legal drinking age, except that a person may obtain an operator's license if he or she is at least 18.

2. Arrest or conviction record

Individuals, all partners (including limited partners), the officers, directors, and agents of corporations, the members, managers and agents of limited liability companies and the officers, directors and agents of nonprofit organizations also:

a. May not have an arrest or conviction record subject to the Wisconsin Fair Employment Act (secs. 111.321, 111.322 and 111.335). Sec. 125.04(5)(a)1. [But see the following Note and items c. and d.] This qualification also applies to corporations and partnerships. However, a corporation with a conviction record may be issued a license if the corporation has terminated its relationship with the individual whose actions directly contributed to the conviction. Sec. 125.04(5)(c).

[Note: The Wisconsin Fair Employment Act (secs. 111.321, 111.322 and 111.335) prohibits discrimination in licensing and employment based on an arrest or conviction record. However, it is not employment discrimination to deny or refuse to renew a license because of a pending arrest record or a conviction record, if the circumstances of the charges substantially relate to the alcohol beverage licensing activity. Sec. 111.335. Intoxicating Liquors 890 (1991).]

- b. Municipal officials may check to see if an applicant has a criminal record by requesting the Crime Information Bureau within the Wisconsin Department of Justice to conduct a criminal history search of the applicant. The Record Check Unit within the Crime Information Bureau can be reached by dialing (608)266-5764. Municipalities must pay a fee for each record check. Requests for record checks must be submitted in writing by mail or online using a record request form provided by the Crime Information Bureau. The Bureau does not accept record check requests by telephone or fax.
 - c. May not be a "habitual law offender." Sec. 125.04(5)(b).

[Note: The term "habitual" refers to multiple convictions (or pending charges). *State ex rel. Smith v. City of Oak Creek*, 139 Wis.2d 788, 407 N.W.2d 901 (1987). It seems likely

that two offenses within a relatively short time period would qualify a person as an "habitual offender." Intoxicating Liquors #890 (1991). The term offender refers to a person with civil violations such as ordinance convictions and/or misdemeanor convictions (or pending charges) which substantially relate to the alcohol beverage licensing activity. The courts have interpreted "habitual offender" to include a person who testified under oath that he had habitually violated the law, even though there were no convictions for the offenses. *City of Oak Creek, supra.*]

d. May not have been convicted of a felony which substantially relates to the alcohol beverage licensing activity. Wis. Stat. sec. 125.04(5)(b).

[Note: To harmonize the above provisions (items a., c. and d.) concerning the qualification of a person with an arrest or conviction record, it appears that although one felony which substantially relates to the licensing activity would lead to nonlicensing, for convictions other than felonies, such as ordinance and misdemeanor convictions, there would have to be repeat offenses to make the person an "habitual law offender." Similarly, for a pending charge (i.e., an arrest record) it appears that a license may not be denied for one pending charge unless that charge is for a felony. Intoxicating Liquors 890 (1991).]

3. Seller's permit

All applicants for retail licenses must provide proof, as required by sec. 77.61(11), that they are in good standing for sales tax purposes (i.e., hold a seller's permit). Sec. 125.04(5)(a)4. This requirement does not apply to applicants for operator's licenses and manager's licenses. It also does not apply to applicants for temporary Class "B" licenses or temporary "Class B" licenses who are not required to hold a seller's permit. Sec. 125.04(5)(d)3.

4. Residency

Individuals, all natural persons in a partnership and the agents of corporations and limited liability companies are subject to the following residency requirement: Sec. 125.04(5)(a)(2).

- a. 90 days continuously in this state prior to the date of application.
- b. The officers and directors of corporations and the members or managers of limited liability companies are not subject to the 90-day state residency requirement.

[Note: The: following may be used to verify residency in Wisconsin for the required time period]

- Voter registration.
- Motor vehicle registration.
- Driver's license.

- Residential lease or purchase agreements.
- Income tax records.

5. Responsible beverage server training course

Individuals, partners and agents of corporations and limited liability companies must have successfully completed a DOR-approved responsible beverage server training course (see http://www.revenue.wi.gov/training/alcSellerServer.html for providers) unless:

- a. The person is renewing a license; or
- b. Within the past two years the applicant held a manager's or operator's license, or held or was agent of a corporation or limited liability company that held a Class "A" beer, Class "B" beer, "Class A" liquor, "Class B" liquor, or "Class C" wine license; or
- c. Within the past two years the person successfully completed such a training course.

6. Partnerships

- a. The names of all partners, including limited partners, must be revealed in the application for a beer and/or liquor license. Brill v. Salzwedel, 235 Wis. 551, 292 N.W. 908 (1940); Sponholz v. Meyer, 270 Wis. 288, 70 N.W.2d 619 (1955); Informal opinion, 5-21-85, Attorney Sheree Robertson of DOR; Intoxicating Liquors 878 (1988).
- b. Adding or dropping of a partner requires application for a new license. The governing body must be given the right to decide on the eligibility of any remaining or new partners for an alcohol beverage license. Informal opinion, 8-6-63, George Thompson, Attorney General.
- c. In general, the 90-day state residency requirement applies to all partners in a partnership, including limited partners. See Robertson opinion and Intoxicating Liquors 878 (1988), above at a. However, the Department has concluded in at least one instance involving a complicated, multi-tiered ownership structure that it was appropriate to apply the qualification standards applicable to corporate applicants to a partnership applicant. In that case, therefore, it was determined that the 90-day state residency requirement did not apply to the partnership applicant. Informal opinion, 1-23-97, Attorney John Evans of DOR.
- d. A partnership may include a corporation, limited liability company or another partnership. A partnership consists of two or more "persons" which may involve a corporation or a partnership as one of the partners.
 - 7. Corporations and limited liability companies
 - a. Corporations and limited liability companies are eligible for the following

licenses:

- Class "B" beer. Sec. 125.26(2).
- "Class B" liquor. Sec. 125.51(3)(c).
- Reserve "Class B" liquor. Sec. 125.51(4)(a)4.
- "Class A" liquor. Sec. 125.51(2)(b).
- Class "A" beer. Sec. 125.25(2)(a).
- "Class C" wine. Sec. 125.51(3m)(c).
- b. Foreign corporations (i.e., out-of-state corporations) and foreign (i.e., out-of-state) limited liability companies are ineligible for "Class C" wine licenses. Wis. Stat. sec. 125.51(3m)(c).
- c. The 90-day state residency requirement is inapplicable to the officers and directors of corporations and the members or managers of limited liability companies. Sec. 125.04(5)(c).
- d. The agents of corporations and limited liability companies must meet the 90-day state residency requirement. See sub. 4, above.
- e. All officers and directors of a corporation and members or managers of a limited liability company must be of legal drinking age and not have an arrest or conviction record subject to the Fair Employment Act. See sub. 2, above.
- f. Business corporations organized under ch. 180 are only required to have one officer. Sec. 180.0840(3). Nonstock nonprofit corporations organized under ch. 181 are required to have two or more officers. Sec. 181.25. Limited liability companies are only required to have one member. Sec. 183.0201.
 - g. Corporate and limited liability company agents: Sec. 125.04(6).
- i. All corporations and limited liability companies applying for an alcohol beverage license must appoint an agent.

[Note: The Department requires, under its powers, appointment of an agent for an association, even though this is not specified in the Statutes.]

ii. A license cannot be issued to a corporation or limited liability company until the agent has been approved by the municipality. In addition to meeting the age, arrest or conviction record and residency requirements, "the agent must, with respect to character, record and reputation, be satisfactory to the issuing authority." Sec. 125.04(6)(a)1.

- iii. The agent must be named in the license or permit and must be given full authority and control over the licensed premises and over all commercial activities on the premises relating to alcohol beverages. Sec. 125.04(6)(a)2.
- iv. Steps to be taken in the appointment of a successor agent: Sec. 125.04(6)(b).
- The corporation or limited liability company must immediately notify the municipal clerk in writing of the appointment of a new agent and the reason for cancellation of the previous agent.
- The newly appointed agent may act in that capacity until approved or disapproved.
- The new agent must complete Forms AT-104 (Schedule for Appointment of Agent) and AT-103 (Auxiliary Questionnaire) and file them with the municipal clerk.
- The license of the corporation or limited liability company shall cease to be in force if prior to the next regular or special meeting of the governing body, the municipal clerk "receives notice of disapproval of the successor agent" by a law enforcement officer of the municipality.
- Sec. 125.04(6)(c). [Consult your attorney, however, before relying on this provision, since it is the governing body that must approve the change.]
- If the change is approved by the governing body, the municipal clerk must amend the license to reflect the change of agent.
- h. A corporation or limited liability company may apply for an alcohol beverage license prior to registration with the Department of Financial Institutions. The license may be granted by the governing body, but it cannot be issued until the foreign/domestic corporation or limited liability company has been registered to do business in this state.
- i. If a corporation or limited liability company changes its name or its officers, directors, stockholders or members or managers:
 - i. The entity need not submit a new application for a license.
- ii. The municipal clerk must be notified within 10 days about any such change. Sec. 125.04(3)(h). Any new officers, directors, members or managers must complete and file with the municipal clerk a Form AT-103 (Auxiliary Questionnaire). A new agent must complete Forms AT-104 (Schedule for Appointment of Agent) and AT-103. See g. 4., above. After approval by the governing body, the municipal clerk must amend the entity's

license to reflect any change of name or change of agent.

[Note: Questions about whether the same or a new corporation is involved may be resolved by requesting a copy of the forms filed by the corporation with the state agency that oversees such records, currently the Wisconsin Department of Financial Institutions (DFI).]

Captain,

Please accept this as my official appeal in writing as I was informed to provide by Lorena Stottler.

I have applied for the Alcohol Beverage Operators License after successfully taking a responsible server course. I received your denial letter stating that my application was denied based on the fact that I failed to disclose all arrests and convictions.

We communicated via email and came to realize where the errors and misunderstandings originated. I was informed by Ms. Stottler that my appeal was being reconsidered due to the new information provided. Sadly I received a phone call the other day stating that my appeal was denied due to me having habitual OWI's. I would like to clarify that 2 OWI's within 14 years is far from habitual in my opinion. The application stated to identify convictions within the past 5 years. If that means that those are the most relevant convictions than I find it highly unfair that I am being judged by a bad decision made when I was 20 years old.

Yes, I have a recent OWI conviction originating from 2015, however despite my conviction I maintain my innocence as I was experiencing a side effect from my illness. I have paid my dues and am embarrassed by what some may consider a "colorful" history. However, I feel that my actions speak much louder than what appears on paper.

To date, I have been a board member for Youth 2 Youth 4 Change. Month after month over the past few years I have sat at a coalition meeting, with you, advocating for a healthier, drug free community. I advocate for our youth and their well being. I have been the executive director for a non profit, Family Respite Care Services for over 6 years until recent budget cuts left me without a job. I have been an Ambassador for the Chamber of Commerce of Greater Beloit, I have been a Zonta Club of Beloit member, and all while volunteering for the Downtown Beloit Association when able.

I have volunteered hours and hours to help make Beloit a better community. I feel that of all people, I would make the most responsible server and this position would allow me to advocate the mission of Y2Y in a different way. Me being a server does not mean I enable drinking and drug use, but it does help me provide for my children as a single mother.

I was told that it is a state law of Wisconsin that prohibits a license from being awarded if the applicant has more than 1 OWI. I reviewed the information online and according to the www.revenue.wi.gov section 10. It states the following:

Can I get a liquor license if I have a criminal record?

That will largely be *up to the municipality to determine*. A *criminal record is not an automatic bar to getting a license*. The municipality must determine whether the violation is something related to the business of selling alcohol beverages. *Violations such as selling liquor without a license, tax evasion, etc., are closely related to this business and might well be a bar to licensing.* A record of auto theft may not. The municipality will weigh the nature of the violation, the *time that has elapsed since the violation*, the person's *overall record in the community*, etc., in making that determination.

With all of this being said, I hereby ask that you reconsider your decision.

I am eager to provide our community as a responsible and caring member of Beloit.

However, the background check located another Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated (OWI) conviction that occurred in 2003. Applicants with two or more OWI convictions traditionally result in a denial of the license.

On Sunday, March 5, 2017, at approximately 1044 hours, I was dispatched to the Bitter's Pub at 1309 Madison Road, for a door that had been kicked in or ran into by a vehicle. Dispatch advised that there were tire tracks and that the RP would be inside the building.

Upon arrival, I observed the rear door of the business was pushed in. I observed tire tracks up to the door and burn out marks where a vehicle had attempted to push the door in. The door was secure and no entry was made.

I then made contact with the RP, Ho Ming Fong, f/w, DOB \blacksquare . Fong stated that

she closed the bar and restaurant at approximately 0240 hours. She, along with another employee, walked around the building to check to make sure doors were secured and windows were secure. Fong stated that this is a normal procedure at close and there was no damage to the building and that there were no vehicles parked in the area of this rear door on the building. Fong stated that their business was then closed up and they left. Fong stated that when she returned today at approximately 1044 hours, she noticed the rear door had been pushed in. Fong did state she checked inside the business and there was no entry made and nothing was messed with inside the business and there was no damage anywhere else on the building. Fong stated that when they closed last night, it was a very calm, uneventful evening and that there were no subjects at the bar that were not regulars and that she did not have any patrons upset with her or any employees. Fong stated that no one has been fired from the business and she has no suspects in this incident. Fong gave no one permission to damage her building.

I asked Fong if she knew the value of the door. Fong stated that she had priced to get the door replaced before and it was approximately three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) for the frame and steel door.

Fong did state that she had insurance and that it was Seitz Insurance. Fong was given the case number for this incident and advised that it will be a criminal damage because there was no entry made into the business. Fong did not have any video on the outside of the building. I also checked across the street and there was a video camera, but it was pointing the opposite direction.

Officer Lynn did perform a neighborhood survey. See his report for further details.

I did value the damage to the door frame and door at approximately three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00). I also valued the damage to the cement wall that was pushed in at approximately two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00). The wall was pushed in and there were cracks in the wall that will need repair. Fong was given the case number for her insurance purposes. Officer Lynn did take photographs of the damage and we did photograph the vehicle tracks.

I did take the black plastic pieces which would be consistent with a motor vehicle, for evidence. One of the pieces was a silver plastic piece, approximately ten to twelve inches (10"-12") long. These vehicle parts were later logged into Evidence at the Beloit Police Department under Evidence Tag #76558 and placed into Locker 17A at the Beloit Police Department.

On Sunday, March 5, 2017, at approximately 1044 hours, myself and Officer Witte were dispatched to 1309 Madison Road, Bitter's Pub, in reference a vehicle hitting the back of the building.

Upon arrival, I did observe that the back steel door had been compromised and damaged along with the cinder block wall to the left of the door as you are facing it.

There were tire marks on the cement sidewalk in front of the door, indicating that the damage had been done by a motor vehicle.

Officer Witte advised that entry had not been made into the building.

I then photographed the damage to the door and the wall. I also took photographs of the tire tracks with and without scale.

None of the vehicles that were in the lot at this time had any damage consistent with the damage done to the back door and cinder block wall.

Officer Witte collected some of the broken car pieces that were left behind.

I then conducted a neighborhood survey. It should be noted that everything in front of Bitter's Pub are businesses. There are several residential houses on the side and in back of 1309 Madison Road, Bitter's Pub. I then made contact with the house on the corner of the Bitter's Pub parking lot at 1275 Madison Road. I made contact with Eva J. Hoff, f/w, DOB which with the WI Driver's License. Hoff informed me that she went to bed at approximately 0300 hours and her bedroom is in the southwest corner of her residence downstairs. She informed me that she can usually hear people getting in and out of cars in the parking lot and when they are talking loud, but said she did not hear anything last night. She informed me that she has three (3) little dogs, two (2) Yorkies and one (1) dachshund that did not bark and they usually will bark at anything they hear.

I was unable to make contact at the following addresses. 1252 Cleveland, 1302 Cleveland and 1318 Cleveland.

I then made contact at 1258 Cleveland with Virginia E. Warren, f/w, DOB , who was positively ID'ed with her WI Driver's License. Warren informed me that she was not home last night and had just arrived back home at approximately 1030 hours.

I advised Officer Witte that I had conducted a neighborhood survey for him and advised that I would place the photos that I took of the crime scene into Evidence.

I then responded to the Beloit Police Department where I placed the photo CD of the criminal damage to property into Evidence under Evidence ID #76559 and placed it in Locker 11A at the Beloit Police Department.

Su told me she printed off a copy of the receipts and provided them to me. I attached a copy of the receipts from these transactions to this report.

Su told me the last four digits of the credit card used was 0188. Su told me she did not have suspect information; however, the phone used to make these calls when placing the order was 678-949-3969. I attempted to call this number and received no contact and was unable to leave a voicemail.

Su told me one delivery was sent to 715 1/2 Oak Street and the other was sent to 318 Carpenter Street. Su told me, based on her past transactions, the phone number which made these orders came back to a female who signed her name as Kayla Govan. I was unable to locate this female in Spillman of CCAP. Su told me she could not remember a description of this female.

I provided Su a copy of the reporting person and my name. Su told me that she received notice today on 03/06/17 from the Dispute Resolution Department, which was investigating the fraudulent transaction. This information told Su that the credit card used to make these purchases was a stolen credit card and the transactions were denied. The Dispute Resolution Department was requesting a police report so the Golden Rice Bowl can be compensated for their loss of product.

I attempted contact at 715 1/2 Oak. No one answered the door. From prior police contacts at 715 1/2 Oak, I knew that no one by the name of Kayla Govan resides there. Contact at 715 1/2 Oak is still pending.

I attempted contact at 318 Carpenter. It should be noted the Keprecious Richardson resides at this address and no one else has been living there, because the landlord has changed the locks while Keprecious is currently in jail awaiting trial for an attempted homicide case.

I have no suspect at this time. Contact at 715 1/2 Oak is still pending.

Martin said that when he went to leave his truck was gone. I asked martin what time he went to go leave and he thought it was 11 pm. I advised Martin that the police were called about midnight and advised that the truck was stolen two hours ago, which would be 10 pm. Martin said that Ming called the police for him and he thought he went to go leave about 11 pm.

I asked Martin if the truck was locked and where his keys were and he said that his truck was unlocked and he left the keys on the floorboard and they were covered up. I saw that Martin was a smoker and I asked him while he was at the bar and when he went outside to smoke if he saw his truck and he said that he did not look towards his truck and that he stayed on the patio area by the front door.

I asked if his truck had any mechanical problems lately and he advised that his truck ran fine with no problems. I asked when the last time he took his truck to a garage for repairs and he advised never. I asked how long he has owned the truck and he said for about 3 years and the truck was paid off. Martin said the truck was valued at \$3000.00 and had about 270,000 miles on the truck. Martin said that he has no insurance on his truck. I asked if there was any body damage to his vehicle and he advised no. Martin said that he did have a toolbox in the back of the truck.

I asked Martin if anybody else knew that he kept his keys to his truck on the floorboard and he said that nobody knew that was where he keeps the keys. I asked Martin how often he keeps the keys inside the truck hidden and he said it was common. Martin said that this was the second time his truck has been stolen. Martin said that about 5 years ago a different truck was stolen while he was at the Grand Slam Bar. Martin said that that time the keys were in the center console when it was stolen. Martin said that the truck was recovered in the church parking lot on Burton. Martin said that nothing was stolen from his truck but some property at the church was damaged.

Martin said that his truck was almost out of gas and that they could not go too

far. Martin said that he has no idea who could possible take his truck. Martin said that no one had permission to take his truck. I asked Martin how many people were at the bar this evening and he said about 10 people and they were all regular customers. Martin said that there were no suspicious customers or new people that did not regularly come to the bar. I asked if he knew if anybody else had any problems with their vehicles parked in the parking lot and he did not know of any other issues.

I asked Martin if he saw all of the fire trucks around 10 pm a block away and he advised that he did not see them, but he heard them. I advised that the fire trucks went to the parking lot of Grommes Millwork parking lot because his truck was on fire. I had to tell Martin several times this information because he did not understand what I was telling him and he appeared to be upset when he finally realized his truck burned up. Martin was advised that his truck was towed away by Hillside Towing.

Martin asked if the inside was burned and I informed him that the incident happened on 2nd Shift and I did not go to the fire call. Martin said several times that someone torched his truck and that it had to be arson. I asked Martin if he had a gas can or anything flammable in his truck and he advised that he did not.

I advised Martin that surveillance video from Grommes Millwork and Expert Electronics will be reviewed because they have exterior cameras and I asked him again if anybody had permission to have his vehicle or if he was driving his vehicle and Martin said that 7:30 pm was the last time he was in his truck and nobody had permission to have his truck.

On Monday 03/06/2017, at approximately 1602 hours, I, Officer Cornell was dispatched to 618 Fourth St. in the City of Beloit, County of Rock, State of Wisconsin regarding a welfare check. Dispatch advised there was a white male wearing jeans, a black jacket and a camo hat walking north on Fourth St. towards the Brass Rail. Dispatch stated there were two callers who advised the male was laying on the ground and then started stumbling while walking. Dispatch stated the male was possibly intoxicated.

I advised Mianecki we received two calls stating he was laying on the ground and stumbling while walking down the street. Mianecki stated he was not stumbling while walking. Mianecki advised he lived on West Grand and he stopped while walking to take a break because he was tired. Mianecki stated he was never laying on the ground but he stopped to sit under a tree.

I asked Mianecki if he had a responsible party that he could be released to and he advised he did not because no one liked him. I asked Mianecki if there was anyone at his residence who could look after him until he sobered up and he stated there was no one at his residence. Mianecki stated he would leave his residence and walk back downtown if he was dropped off at home.

I spoke with a staff member at Rock County Crisis and advised Mianecki was intoxicated without a responsible party that he could be released to. The staff member at Crisis advised Mianecki would need to go to the hospital for medical clearance before an evaluation for a 51.45 could take place.

I contacted Sergeant Elrod and he told me to bring Mianecki down to the police départment before going to the hospital to see if he would blow into a preliminary breath test (PBT).

Officer Highland and I escorted Mianecki to the back of my squad car (blue 2). While getting into the back of the car, Mianecki stated he did not fit because he was too fat. Mianecki started screaming that his body hurt and he could not sit in the car with his hands behind his back.

Officer Highland and I assisted Mianecki to the back of Officer Highland's SUV squad car. While walking to the squad car, Mianecki stumbled and almost lost his balance.

Officer Highland and I went to the Beloit Police Department and we attempted to have Mianecki blow into a PBT. Mianecki refused multiple times to blow into the PBT. I attempted to explain to Mianecki that he was not in trouble for being intoxicated. I told Mianecki we just had to see how intoxicated he was but he continued to refuse. Sergeant Elrod attempted to speak with Mianecki but Mianecki still refused to blow into the PBT and said we were "illegally detaining him because he did nothing wrong".

Sergeant Elrod requested we take Mianecki to Beloit Memorial Hospital. Officer Highland transported Mianecki to the hospital and I met them there.

Upon arrival at the hospital, Mianecki stated we were being "pricks" for illegally detaining him. Mianecki requested we remove the handcuffs from him so he can walk out of the hospital. Mianecki was escorted to room 9 in the emergency room where he was medically cleared by hospital staff. Mianecki refused to give the nurses a blood sample and officers had to assist with holding Mianecki's arms down so a blood draw could be conducted. Mianecki attempted to spit on Officer Highland while his arm was being held down for the blood draw. Mianecki stated he was sorry and he was just trying to blow on Officer Highland. Officer Highland advised there was no spit on him. Hospital staff advised they needed a urine sample from Mianecki but he refused. Mianecki stated he would be talking to his lawyer because officers were illegally detaining him, taking his blood and making him provide a urine sample when he did nothing wrong. Mianecki advised his hard earned tax dollars were supporting police to take innocent people who just want to drink alcohol off the street. Mianecki stated it is not illegal to drink alcohol and he wanted to be released from the hospital so he could go have another drink.

Mianecki stated several times he wanted to leave the hospital and he attempted to leave his hospital bed several times. Because Mianecki was uncooperative and continued to try and leave the hospital room, Officer Highland secured both of Mianecki's wrists in handcuffs attached to the hospital bed.

Mianecki advised his nurse he drank approximately four gallons of an "alcoholic beverage". Mianecki was also requesting the nurse give him heroin. Mianecki's nurse later advised Mianecki was medically cleared and he had a BAC of .360.

Mianecki advised he liked to drink and detox was not going to work for him. Mianecki stated he was an old man and he is not going to change his ways. Mianecki advised he will start drinking again as soon as he leaves Tellurian. Mianecki advised detox only works for "young guys" who want to change their drinking habits.

Due to Mianecki's high level of intoxication, behavior, and inability to find a responsible party to take care of him, Mianecki was placed on a 51.45. Mianecki's behavior demonstrated he was incapacitated by alcohol and he was unable to make rational decisions.

I spoke with Bob at Rock County Crisis and advised I was placing Mianecki on a 51.45. Bob advised Mianecki could be transported to Tellurian Detoxification Center in Madison.

Officer Rohrer and I transported Mianecki to Tellurian and he was turned over to staff there. Mianecki told staff at Tellurian, "I have too much blood in my alcohol system." Before I left Tellurian, Mianecki said, "see you next week."

On 03/06/17, at approximately 1611 hours, I responded to the intersection of Fourth and St. Lawrence in the City of Beloit, WI, reference a check welfare.

Dispatch gave a description of a white male with blue jeans, a black jacket, and a camouflage baseball hat. Dispatch also advised that the male was stumbling near the way of traffic on Fourth, as well as laying on the ground near traffic.

Upon my arrival to the area of Fourth and St. Lawrence, I did observe a white male matching the description given by dispatch. I observed the male walking south on Fourth, towards Palermo's.

At this time, I approached the male subject at Fourth and Ironworks. I observed the male to be stumbling as he attempted to walk away from me. Upon making contact with the male, I could smell a strong odor of intoxicants emanating from his person. I asked the male to identify himself, and the male refused to identify himself and stated that he was going home.

I asked the male where he lived and if anyone was at his residence that would be able to look after him while he was intoxicated. At this time, I detained the male by placing his hands behind his back and handcuffing him. The handcuffs were checked for fit and double locked. I advised the male that he was being detained, so I could attempt to identify him. I did observe a wallet in the male's back right pocket. I retrieved the wallet, in an attempt to identify him. I did find a WI photo ID card that resembled the male I detained. The male was identified as Alec J. Mianecki, M/W,

I then placed Mianecki in the back of Squad G-5 and transported him to the Beloit Police Department, in an attempt to give Mianecki a Preliminary Breath Test to determine his level of intoxication. Mianecki refused the Preliminary Breath Test.

I then transported Mianecki to the Beloit Memorial Hospital to be medically cleared.

While at the Beloit Memorial Hospital, Mianecki became very uncooperative and attempted to spit on me while securing Mianecki to the bed, to allow the hospital staff to draw blood from Mianecki's arm. While speaking with Fowler, I could smell an odor of intoxicants coming from his breath. Fowler was also slurring his words and he had trouble standing on his own. I then had Dispatch conduct an NCIC query of Fowler. Dispatch advised that Fowler had a current AWC through Rock County. I then advised Fowler he was under arrest for the Arrest Warrant Commitment.

I instructed Fowler to turn around and place his hands behind his back, which he did. I handcuffed Fowler with his hands behind his back using two sets of handcuffs because of his physique, I checked the restraints for fit and double-locked them for safety. I conducted a search of Fowler's person incident to an arrest, which produced negative results. I then advised Dispatch they could confirm Fowler's warrant, which they did. On Monday 03/20/2017 at approximately 2311 hours, I, Officer Ryan Kelly, was dispatched to Mikes Roadhouse Bar located at 614 Broad St. in the City of Beloit, Rock County, WI 53511 regarding a disturbance. The reporting person who I later identified by WI ID as Lucas C. Stevenson, M/W, 2005. 141 W. School St. Sharon, WI 53585 stated that Curtis Simplot struck him in the face.

I arrived on scene at approximately 2315 hours and made contact with Stevenson inside the bar. Stevenson stated that Simplot, who I later positively identified as Curtis I. Simplot, M/W, 230 S. Gilbert, Footville, WI. had struck him in the face.

Stevenson stated that Simplot and he have had ongoing issues between them for approximately one year. Stevenson stated that Simplot was at the bar playing darts and Stevenson was playing the slot machines. Stevenson stated that he was speaking with a mutual friend of his and Simplot's and left the machines to go up to the bar. Stevenson stated that he was approached by Simplot who stated to Stevenson "why don't you talk shit now." Stevenson stated that he did not say anything back to Simplot and attempted to leave the bar. Stevenson stated that Simplot then struck him in the mouth with the back side of his open hand. Stevenson stated that this act caused him pain and was done without permission. Stevenson stated that the act was done intentionally by Simplot.

I observed Stevenson's face and observed no injures or red marks to his face. I searched Simplot in Spillman and attempted to contact him at the listed phone number, but the phone was inactive.

I was later advised by dispatch that Simplot had contacted them wishing to speak with me. I did speak with Simplot over the phone who stated that he would come to the Beloit Police Department on 03/21/2017 at approximately 2300 hours.

On 03/21/2017 at approximately 2300 hours Simplot did come to the Beloit Police Department. I spoke with Simplot regarding the incident after positively identifying him by WI DL. Simplot stated that he was at the bar with his dart team shooting darts. Simplot stated that Stevenson entered the bar and began speaking with Adam Eichman who is a mutual friend of Simplot's and Stevenson's. Simplot stated that he and Stevenson have not gotten along for a long time due to ongoing issues involving an unidentified female. Simplot stated that he avoided Stevenson, until Simplot attempted to leave the bar to smoke a cigarette.

Simplot advised me that Stevenson was standing near the bar and Simplot had to walk past him to go outside. Simplot stated that when he walked passed, Stevenson stated " you better keep walking." Simplot stated that he turned to Stevenson at which time they began arguing. Simplot stated that he told Stevenson " you are not worth a punch, maybe a flick" and made a flicking motion in Stevenson's face, but never touched Stevenson. Simplot stated that the bartender, who he identified as Mary Turner, advised Simplot to leave the bar before anything further happened. Simplot stated that he did leave the bar without any further incident.

Simplot stated that Mary turner and another bartender who he identified as Bridgette Aston witnessed the incident and would corroborate Simplot's statements to me.

At this time, I have received conflicting stories from both parties and do not have probable cause to arrest Simplot or Stevenson. I will conduct follow up and attempt to positively identify the bartenders.

On Saturday 03/04/2017 at 2329 hrs, Lt Kaltenbrun and several Detectives were doing a security check at the Turtle Tap Bar. They discovered an unresponsive subject inside a Jeep Cherokee with WI Plate 184WBY. Beloit Fire/EMS was dispatched to this incident. Sgt Dykstra requested that I also respond to this incident.

Upon my arrival, the Beloit EMS were removing the subject from the vehicle and began caring for the subject. The subject's pockets were checked for weapons and contraband before the EMS started treatment. The subject had a WI ID card in his pocket and he was identified as, Benjamin Kettle. No contraband was located on his person.

The Beloit EMS administered Narcan to Kettle and he started coming around. It is believed that Kettle was in a drug overdose. I did search the vehicle that Kettle was unresponsive in and I was unable to locate any drugs, pill bottles, baggies, paraphernalia, or anything that would identify what Kettle ingested.

I followed the ambulance to the Beloit ER and Kettle appeared to be confused and was unaware where he was at. Kettle said that he does not know where he was at or what had happened.

I asked Kettle what was the last thing he remembered and he said that he got off of work around 3:00 pm and he was at the Turtle Tap bar around 4:00 pm and he was drinking a Mt Dew. I asked Kettle if he was inside the bar or was he just outside in his vehicle and Kettle said that he was inside the bar drinking a Mt Dew.

I asked Kettle if he had any problems with anybody inside the bar and he advised that he did not have a problem with anybody. I asked Kettle if anybody gave him anything to try or did anybody buy him any drinks and Kettle said that nobody bought him any drinks.

I asked Kettle how did he get narcotics in his system because the Paramedics gave him Narcan and that brought him back from the overdose. Kettle advised that he does not know how that happened because he said that he doesn't do drugs anymore. I asked Kettle when was the last time he used drugs and he stated that it was several years since he used drugs. I asked Kettle what his drug of choice was when he did use drugs and he advised that he would take Percocet.

I asked Kettle if he was with anybody during this incident and Kettle said that he was by himself. I asked Kettle where he works and he said that he works construction and he just works side jobs. Kettle was unable to provide me with anybody that was with him during the time that he was at Turtle Tap Bar.

I asked Kettle if he was trying to harm himself in reference to the overdose and Kettle advised that he was not trying to hurt himself.

The ER had blood drawn and the results showed that Kettle did not have any alcohol in his system. The ER nursing staff wanted Kettle to provide a urine sample and he was refusing to provide urine as he was telling them that he did not take any drugs.

I informed Sgt Sayles of the status of this drug overdose incident. I did not

have any criminal charges and Kettle did not have any alcohol in his system, so he was not going to be a 51.45 commitment and he was simply being treated at the hospital for the overdose.

I also informed Sgt Sayles that Kettle was on Parole for OWI 4th Offense and he has a restriction that he was not to be at a bar. Sgt Sayles advised that my report will be forwarded to Probation and Parole for this incident.

It should also be noted that in December of 2016, the Janesville Police Dept had a similar incident where Kettle was found unresponsive in a vehicle.
