INFORMATION REGARDING CONSTRUCTION ON I-39/90 PROJECT

The Project Communications Manager for the I-39/90 Project provides the following information for the week of May 22-26:

Temporary widening of I-39/90 southbound, near Beloit

Between the County S (Shopiere Road) interchange and the Illinois state line

- Nighttime paving to start along I-39/90 southbound, from County S toward Stateline Road
- Crews to stain the Woodman Road bridge during nighttime lane closures.
- Traffic shifted on I-39/90 southbound near I-43/WIS 81 interchange. Please be alert and stay in your lane!

Hart Road bridge girder repairs, near Beloit

- Crews to remove damaged girder on Wednesday night. Noise is expected with these operations.
- I-39/90 slowdowns anticipated Wednesday night (May 24) as crews remove and replace the girder.
- Be alert for crews and equipment in this area.
- Hart Road to be CLOSED to local traffic from 7:00 a.m. Tuesday (May 23) until Friday morning (May 26). Alternate local routes are required.

Stateline Road bridge replacement over I-39/90, near Beloit

- Center pier removal to take place during nighttime hours. Some noise is anticipated.
- Traffic shifts in place at the Wisconsin state line. Be alert for lane changes in this area!
- Stateline Road over I-39/90 CLOSED to all traffic until mid-August 2017. Alternate local routes are required.
