OUTDOOR SWIMMING POOLS

Drew Pennington, Director of Planning and Building Services, reminds residents that all outdoor swimming pools capable of holding more than two feet of water must be surrounded by a fence that is at least four feet in height and must have a valid permit prior to installation. Above-ground swimming pools that are available at area retailers are subject to these requirements. In addition, all swimming pools must be properly disinfected and pools deeper than four feet require a throwing buoy and lifeline. Residents with previously permitted and fenced swimming pools do not need to take any further action. Permits are available weekdays from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. in the Planning and Building Services Division on the 3rd floor of City Hall, 100 State Street. If you have questions, or want to report an unsafe swimming pool, please call 608-364-6700.
