The regular meeting of the Municipal Golf Committee of the City of Beloit, WI was held on May 17th, 2017 at the Krueger Haskell Golf Course Clubhouse. The meeting was called to order at 7:02 a.m.

1. Call to Order – Ed Armstrong called meeting to order at 7:02 AM.

- 2. **Approve Minutes from April 19th, 2017 Meeting** Ed Armstrong had corrections to the minutes: 7. Concessionaire Report 2nd sentence change contract to contact. The final paragraph Ed Armstrong entertained the motion for adjournment. Bill Maze made the motion for adjournment. Ed Armstrong comments on page 3, in regards to the article coming out, Ed asked when will the article come out and Mark's response was sometime in April. Gary Gard 4. Club Reports seniors remove last line so returnee players. Motion to accept changes to minutes Gary Gard; seconded by Harry Wiersgalla. Motion passed unanimously.
- 3. **Citizen Participation-** Mark Preuschl is now going to be a City Council Representative for the meetings.

4. Club Reports

- Men's We have sign up for The Rock Cup for June 10th 11th, 2017. This is an event between Krueger Men's League and the Beloit Club Men's League. We have 40 participants 20 from each group. Men's League first meeting scheduled for Thursday, May 18, 2017 at 4:30 pm. Participation is about where we anticipated around 80 members.
- Women's Tuesday, May 16^{th} , 2017 was the first time Women's League could golf in month of May. There are 7 18 holer teams and 6 9 holer teams.

- Seniors Week of May 12th, 2017 had 59 players for 9 teams. May 19th, 2017 will not play due to a Crime Stoppers Event that day. Picked up total of 2 new players.
- Mark Preuschl asked if they advertise at Grinnell Hall. Gary stated we have this group since 1983 and it is by word of mouth.

5. Manager of Golf Operations Report-

- **Financial Report** Daily Fee Report month of April was \$8,989 combined February and March have a good start. April daily fees were down due to the weather. Season passes for April \$18,616. \$20,000 short on passes. We need sell the single season passes. Cart passes were below projection, which will pick up in May. The weather for the first part May has not cooperated.
- Saturday, May 13, 2017 play day for Community Against Cancer had 52 golfers. Friday, May 19, 2017 have Crime Stoppers play day with 14 foursomes and Saturday, May 20, 2017 have Kamppi play day with 19 foursomes scheduled.
- Mark contacted Golf Now to do an email blast and get other items on social media to get more play that is helping the revenue.
 College kids are back staff will be better in club house and on the course.
- Marketing We use Twitter, Facebook and Golf Now. Placing ads in The Beloit Daily News and Instagram. Golf Now has been sending out emails for extra daily play. Five (5) Play Days booked for June and hosting the Father/Child Tournament which will be held one day of the June 17th weekend.
- **Special Projects** There are no special projects right now. Gary Gard stated that they have about \$3,000 from the T-sign advertisement to give to projects.
- **Cart Shed Roof** Mark wanted to thank Ed Armstrong for doing work on the cart shed roof.
- 6. **Director's Report** Concerned with season pass sales. Currently at 77% for season pass sales. We are proposing win a cart pass with a purchase of a season pass. This is for all golfers who have purchased a 2017 season pass or for purchasing for the first time this year. Season pass holders will have their name entered into the drawing for every new pass purchased. The more referrals the more chances to win a season cart pass.
- 7. **Concessionaire Report** Tom Hankins was able to report that it has been slow start for him. He opened on April 1, 2017. The weather has not been our friend. A lot of days were closed. He says he has to crawl before he can walk. When he is open he is busy, the crowds are hanging around. Tom stated he had a good weekend for the Community Against Cancer May 13th, 2017. The participants for this play day have gone down. Kamppi dropped from 140 to 80 participants. It seems to be a trend for

the play days to have fewer participants. Tom has 2 nice events the weekend of May 20th and 21st, 2017. Good things are coming. Tom stated the participants in the play days are not as many as previous years. Tom is has some ideas he wants to try. They are going to open the outside grill this weekend.




