HOLIDAY TRAVEL—"SAFETY NEVER TAKE A HOLIDAY"

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation sent the following information:

"Construction work on most major highway projects throughout the state will be suspended during the Labor Day weekend to help travelers reach their destination safely and efficiently. Construction in highway work zones, including most operations related to the I-39/90 Project, will stop by noon today (Sept. 1) and will not resume until 6 a.m. Tuesday (Sept. 5).

Due to the heavy holiday traffic, backups and delays are anticipated on I-39/90 this afternoon and Monday afternoon (Sept. 4). All lanes and interchange ramps along I-39/90, between Beloit and Madison, are OPEN except for the US 51 ramp to I-39/90 northbound. The northbound Interstate ramp to the US 51 interchange (Stoughton Exit 156) is OPEN."

SEALCOATING PUBLIC PARKING LOTS

CITY COUNCIL VACANCY

The City Council of Beloit is now accepting applications to fill a vacancy on the City Council. This recruitment is to fill the council seat recently vacated by Sheila DeForest. The term for this office will end in April 2018.

<u>Timeline</u>. Application acceptance closes on **September 15, 2017 at 5:00 p.m.** The Council will hold interviews on **September 20, 2017 at 6:30 p.m.** and finalists are required to personally appear before the council.

<u>Form of Government</u>. The City of Beloit is a City Manager/Council form of government organized under Chapter 64 of the Wisconsin State Code. Chapter 64 describes the powers of the Council.

64.07. Powers of council; its organization; quorum; meetings.

(1) The council shall possess and exercise all legislative and general ordinance powers imposed and conferred by general law or special charter upon the mayor and common council and the various boards and commissions not inconsistent with ss. 64.01 to 64.15, and in force in such city at the time of its reorganization and such additional powers as are hereinafter imposed and conferred, but such council shall not have the power to enact special executive or administrative orders, it being the intent of ss. 64.01 to 64.15 to separate the legislative and executive powers of city government.

<u>Qualifications</u>. An applicant must be a resident of the City of Beloit, be 18 years old and cannot be convicted of a misdemeanor involving a violation of the public trust or a felony.

<u>Position and Duties</u>. The City Council serves as the legislative arm of City government. It decides policy matters. The Council enacts ordinances, resolutions and motions; approves and amends the budget, levies taxes; approves/denies certain claims made against the City and approves/denies certain licenses issued by the City. The Council meetings are regularly scheduled for the first and third Mondays of the month. The meetings are scheduled at 7:00pm, with council agenda workshops immediately preceding regular council meetings at 6:30pm. There are other special meetings from time to time and council members are expected to attend all meetings unless excused.
