CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Jeff Johnson at 6:30 p.m.

REVIEW OF MINUTES FROM THE OCTOBER 11, 2017 MEETING

OLD BUSINESS -

- a.) Hope Park Lee Recreation was chosen at the Playground Selection Meeting on Tuesday, October 24, 2017. Lee Recreation has been mailed the two (2) copies of the contract sign and return one (1). Construction will begin in first part of May 2018.
- **b.)** POROS PLAN Jodine has contacted Todd from Design Perspectives and put together a Summary of Public Findings and a plan update. This is for the committee to review after the meeting and if they had any questions or comments to either call or email her and she would respond with an answer or save the information for the next meeting.
- c.) CIP budget for 2018 Budgets were approved by Council on Monday, November 6, 2017. Jodine attached 2018 2023 CIP Project Request and Enhancements. 2018 the following items will be addressed:
 - Parking Lots of Big Hill, Lesson Park, Telfer Park, Krueger Park, and Telfer Park will be vast majority of fixes in 2018
 - Brooks Street Park Replace Playground
 - Summit Park Soccer Field Renovations

Mike Ciaramita questions – are the parking lots going to be marked for ADA Compliance – Mark Edwards will ask Jason Dupis on this.

Jeff Johnson was looking for East Lawn Cemetery Roadway improvements? Mark Edwards said that would be in the Engineering CIP Projects, which he will check on.

Jeff also is questioning what happened to the Big Hill – Phase II Bike Trail. It is not listed on the CIP. Has it been eliminated? Could it be under Engineering? Jodine will find out and

would email everyone where it is. Jeff Johnson wants the Bike Trail finished and it got pushed back. Jeff wants to make sure it was not eliminated.

Carl – question what will happen with the Turtle Creek Bath House, Mark has been given the approval to paint the bath house and get it up to nicer looking standards until it can be renovated.

- d.) BMHS tennis courts usage Mark met with Joel the AD to discuss the potential of using the tennis courts in the summer. Joel is new to the whole process, so Mark did not get any direct answers. This project will be kept on as old business. Mark wants to have meetings with Joel, and Spencer Waite the Recreations Supervisor to start dialog regarding the exchange of services agreement. We have a partnership of services between the School District and the City of Beloit Parks and Recreation for the exchanging the use of facilities between the both entities, but there is nothing in writing. Until we get an agreement in place Joel will not leave the nets up for the summer. Jeff Johnson wants to keep tennis courts on the agenda as old business until we have a solution as to whether or not we are going to spend the \$100,000 to replace Riverside Tennis Courts.
- **e.)** Carp Kill Mark spoke with the DNR and it was a koyherpes virus which attacked the carp only. It was not from the extreme hot weather. It just happens to coincide with the hot weather.

- 4. Cleaned up Big Hills Center basement. Paula Schutt is going to be starting up a program in the basement for individuals with Parkinson's disease. It is going to be a boxing program, with heavy bags and sparing which will help individuals get their bodies moving and their muscles more limber.

- 6. Volleyball has begun with 63 teams versus 74 from 2016.


ADJOURNMENT
