2 ARRESTED FOLLOWING NARCOTICS INVESTIGATIONS IN БЕLOIT

Beloit Police Department collaborated with the Wisconsin Department of Justice's Division of Criminal Investigation in executing search warrant.

April 3, 2018 - The Beloit Police Department announces the arrests of two individuals related to heroin and cocaine trafficking in the Beloit area. These arrests were made in collaboration with the Wisconsin Department of Justice's Division of Criminal Investigation.

Markis D. Crenshaw, age 30, was arrested following the execution of a search warrant in the 1900 block of Saint Lawrence Avenue on Friday, March 30. Crenshaw was booked into the Rock County Jail and awaits charges for five deliveries of cocaine and/or heroin, possession with the intent to deliver heroin and cocaine, and maintaining drug trafficking place. Crenshaw was also taken into custody on a probation hold by the Department of Corrections.

Deon Young, age 42, was arrested following the execution of a no-knock search warrant on Tuesday, April 3, in the 700 block of Euclid Avenue. Young was booked at the Rock County Jail on multiple felony warrants. Young also faces potential future charges involving the delivery of heroin and maintaining a drug trafficking place.

"The Beloit Police Department has an excellent working relationship with DCI," Police Chief David Zibolski said. "We continue to partner with the state on large-scale investigations and operations in order to bring individuals like Crenshaw and Young to justice. The message is clear - dangerous drugs like heroin and cocaine have no place in our community. If you bring them here, you will be caught."
