**In-Person Absentee Voting Runs through Friday, Aug. 10**

**August 1, 2018** - Early voting for the fall primary election is now available in the Clerk-Treasurer's office at City Hall, 100 State St., Beloit.

In-person absentee voting will be available through Friday, Aug. 10, 2018. The election will be held on Tuesday, Aug. 14, 2018.

The City of Beloit Clerk-Treasurer's office is also accepting absentee ballot requests in writing to receive ballots via the mail. Your written request must list your voting address within the municipality where you wish to vote, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different, and your signature. You may make application for an absentee ballot by mail or in person. The deadline for making application to receive an absentee ballot by mail is 5 p.m. Aug. 9, 2018. Any ballots received after the polls close will not be counted.
