3. Club Reports:

- Men's: 110 members in the Men's Club. City tournament had 62 participants (decrease from 2017 at 84). SWANI 136 golfers with 20 golfers as season pass holders. 116 golfers will purchase golf/cart. 10 to 12 will walk but most will ride in a cart. Most golfers are from out of town with about 20 from Beloit. Men's Club Play day is 9/22/18. Scramble at 1 pm with a 4 man scramble approximately 48 golfers with a steak dinner around 6 pm and prizes.
- Women's: Nothing to report.
- Senior's: Still looking for a representative. Scramble on Fridays around 70 golfers and have around 16 on weekdays.

4. Manager of Golf Operations Report:

- Financial Report: July broke even with last year's July (2017). Daily fees up by \$1,000. Season passes are same and cart passes are up. Cart rentals are up. \$5,000 down from 2017 due to daily fees off to a bad start in April, 2018. Taylor Freeze has 88 golfers for their play day. Play days coming up: 8/25 24 and 30 golfers. Woodward Governor on October 6th with approximately 140 golfers.
- **Expenses:** We're ahead \$60,000. \$308,000 revenue with \$246,000 in expenses.
- Marketing: Discussed Rockford Park District's issue on increasing revenue and play. Talked about population and too many golf courses being built.
- **Special Projects:** Tree stumps removal hopefully soon; we are running behind. Equipment running good; fairway mower is up for replacement (13 years old).
