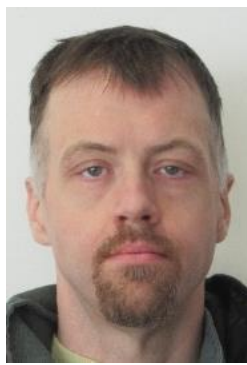

SEX OFFENDER RELEASE - COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Oct. 10, 2018 - The Wisconsin Department of Corrections has notified the Beloit Police Department that Jeremy J. Simons, 37, was released from prison on Feb. 13, 2018. He now resides at 1850 Madison Road, Beloit, WI.

The purpose of this notification is to ensure safe neighborhoods by informing the public when a sex offender who qualifies for a Special Bulletin Notification is released into the Beloit community. On June 1, 1997, Wisconsin State Statute 301.45 (Act 440), the Sex Offender Registration and Community Notification Law, took effect to enhance public safety and protection.

Simon's targeted victims were juvenile males and females. He was convicted of causing a child to view/listen to sex act and possession of child pornography in Rock County Circuit Court in May 2006.

Simons remains on supervision until Feb. 21, 2021, and is required to register with the Wisconsin Sex Offender Registry. He also will be on lifetime GPS monitoring.

Conditions of supervision include:

- No unsupervised contact with minors
- No taverns/bars/liquor stores
- No contact with the victim(s)
- Not to consume alcohol or drugs

- Comply with standard sex offender rules
- Cooperate with electronic monitoring
- Face-to-face contact with law enforcement
- Comply with all requirements and lifetime registration of the Wisconsin Sex Offender Registry
