In-Person Absentee Voting Runs through Friday, Nov. 2

Oct. 11, 2018 - In-person absentee voting for November election is now available in the Clerk-Treasurer's office at City Hall, 100 State St., Beloit.

In-person absentee voting will be available until 5 p.m. Friday, Nov. 2, 2018. The election will be held on Tuesday, Nov. 6, 2018.

The City of Beloit Clerk-Treasurer's office is also accepting absentee ballot requests in writing to receive ballots via the mail. Your written request must list your voting address within the municipality where you wish to vote, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different, and your signature. You may make application for an absentee ballot by mail or in person. The deadline for requesting to receive an absentee ballot by mail is 5 p.m. Nov. 1, 2018. Note that any ballots received after the polls close on Election Day will not be counted.
