City of Beloit Closing Offices, Delaying Services Due to Unsafe Weather Conditions

Jan. 29, 2019 - Due to the unsafe weather conditions, the City of Beloit is closing its administrative offices and most buildings starting Wednesday, Jan. 30, through noon Thursday, Jan. 31. City Hall, all Public Works buildings, Edwards Ice Arena and Grinnell Hall will be closed during that time period.

The following cancellations or adjustments are in effect:

- Beloit Transit service is cancelled during this time period. Service will resume at noon Thursday, Jan. 31.
- All recreation programs are cancelled on Tuesday, Jan. 29, and Wednesday, Jan. 30. Recreation programs scheduled for the afternoon and evening of Thursday, Jan. 31, are currently on as scheduled.
- Garbage and recycling pick up will be delayed by one day. Wednesday's pick up will be on Thursday and Thursday's pickup will be on Friday.
- The Beloit Public Library will remain open as a warming center with limited staffing; the Blender Café will be closed.
- Individuals who were scheduled to appear in court on Thursday morning will receive notification via the mail about a new court date.

Please stay indoors during these extreme weather conditions and check in on family members or friends who may be vulnerable during this time. Prolonged exposure in this weather can result in frostbite and hypothermia; please do not travel unless absolutely necessary.
